
If you have not already, move the assembled bases to your desired outdoor location. They become difficult to move once poles and other parts are attached.




1. Begin assembly of the large tree by opening the legs of the Large Tree Base & Wire Frame (A) so they are perpendicular. Attach the wire frames to form a circle. (Note: The large tree base has 8 raised notches on the wire frame.) Begin assembly of the small tree by opening the legs of the Small Tree Base & Wire Frame (B) so they are perpendicular. Attach the wire frames to form a circle. (Note: The small tree base has 6 raised notches on the wire frame.)




2. Form the tree skirt of the large tree by snapping together the Control Panel (C) and 3 Plastic Tree Skirts (D). Form the tree skirt of the small tree by snapping together 4 Plastic Tree Skirts (D).




3. Secure the large tree skirt by pushing a Tree Skirt Connector Ring (E) onto the newly formed circle at the top. Place tree skirt on top of the Large Tree Base & Wire Frame (A). Secure the small tree skirt by pushing a Tree Skirt Connector Ring (E) onto the newly formed circle at the top. Place tree skirt on top of the Small Tree Base & Wire Frame (B).



4. Assemble 2 Tree Poles (K) and slide them into the top circle of the large tree base. Assemble 1 Tree Pole (K) and slide it into the top circle of the small tree base.




5. Stake each tree base into the ground with 4 Metal U-Shaped Stakes (J) by placing stakes across from each other along the wire frame, avoiding the raised notches.




6. Taking care to protect the bulbs and wiring, connect the Light String Set with Star Topper (C) onto the top pole of the large tree. (Note: The Light String Set (C) is hardwired to the Control Panel, so handle it carefully without yanking, dropping or moving abruptly.) Taking care to protect the bulbs and wiring, connect the Light String Set with Star Topper (F) onto the top of the pole of the small tree.




7. Carefully align each light string toward a raised notch in the base wire frame. Starting with light string number 1 on the large tree, secure the light string to a raised notch. Repeat in a clockwise fashion for strings numbered 2-8, in numbered order. Tighten each light string with the cinch clip until taut. Repeat the procedure for the small tree, securing light strings numbered 1-6 in a clockwise fashion and cinching until taut.



8. Connect the large and small trees together by attaching their cables (female connector on large tree to male connector on small tree).




9. Connect the UL Listed Adapter (I) to the Control Panel (C) on the large tree (female connector on the adapter to male connector on the control panel).




11. Slide the Speaker Stake (G) into place on the bottom of the Speaker (H) and snap into place. Carefully insert the Speaker Stake (G) into the ground.


