Organize your parts and hardware. You will need a Phillips head screw driver.

Hardware:

A: Large bolts(4) • B: medium bolts(4) • C: small bolts(3) D: Wood screws(3) • E: Locking washers(9)

F: Washers(9) • G: Wood caps(2) • H: Allen Key • I: Glue








NOTE: EACH BOLT EXCEPT FOR 2 SMALL BOLTS GETS 1 LOCK WASHER FOLLOWED BY 1 FLAT WASHER.


Parts:

J: Back Frame • K: Seat Frame • L: Seat Cushion• M: Leg/Arm(2)











IMPORTANT NOTICE:

- Place all wooden parts on a clean and smooth surface such as a rug or carpet to avoid the parts from being scratched.
- Check to be sure that you have all parts and hardware.
- Remove all wrapping materials, including staples & packing straps before you start to assemble.
- Do not tighten all screws/bolts until completely assembled.
- Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.




STEP 4b: Using downward force, slide seat cushion(L) into position, then attach using 3 wood screws(D).



STEP 5a: Secure both Leg/Arms(M) to Back Frame(J) using one small bolt(C) each.

NOTE: These two small bolts DO NOT include flat washer & locking washer



STEP 5b: Finish by plugging the holes with wood caps(G) using the glue(I).
