



Cannas are among the most colorful summer bulbs with ruffled spikes tapering to refined buds and paddle shaped leaves. Their reedy canes and palmy foliage create magnificent plants, yielding blooms all summer long for long lasting curb appeal. They are deer resistant and appear most dramatic when grouped in masses. These are fast growers with large flowers.

About This Variety: Cannasol™ cannas are a newer variety of cannas grown in The Netherlands that are grown from tissue culture. They are said to be virus free, long blooming and compact in size. Best of all they are hardy in USDA zones 3-10.

Growing Instructions: Plant 1 bulb/rhizome per square foot. Cannas do best with a good supply of water.

Care Tip: As flowers fade, deadhead to promote continued flowering. Prefer moist conditions.

Blooms: Summer to Fall Exposure: Full Sun to Partial Shade Height: Grows 18-22" tall Spacing: Plant 12" apart, 2-4" deep USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 3-10
