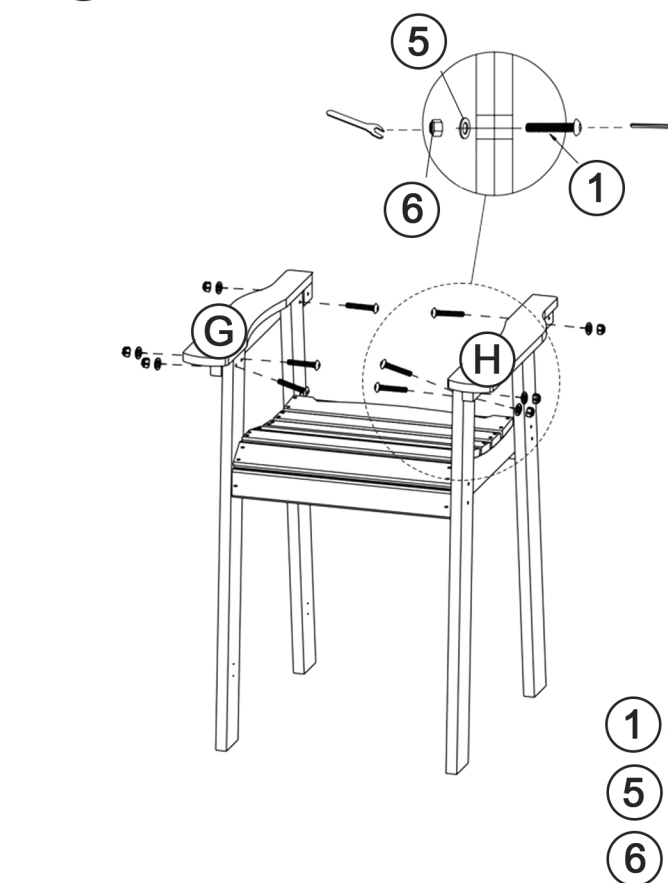


STEP 1

Place all chair parts on a soft and smooth surface to prevent scratching.

Attach "Front Legs (C/D)" to "Chair Seat Frame (B)" - Using "1 M6 x 75MM Bolts & Washer & Nut", tighten with hex key and wrench.

Attach "Rear Legs (E/F)" to "Chair Seat Frame (B)" - Using "1 M6 x 75MM Bolts & Washer & Nut", tighten with hex key and wrench.



STEP 2

Attach "Chair Arms (G/H)" to "Legs (C/D/E/F)" - Using "1 M6 x 75MM Bolts & Washer & Nut", tighten with hex key and wrench.

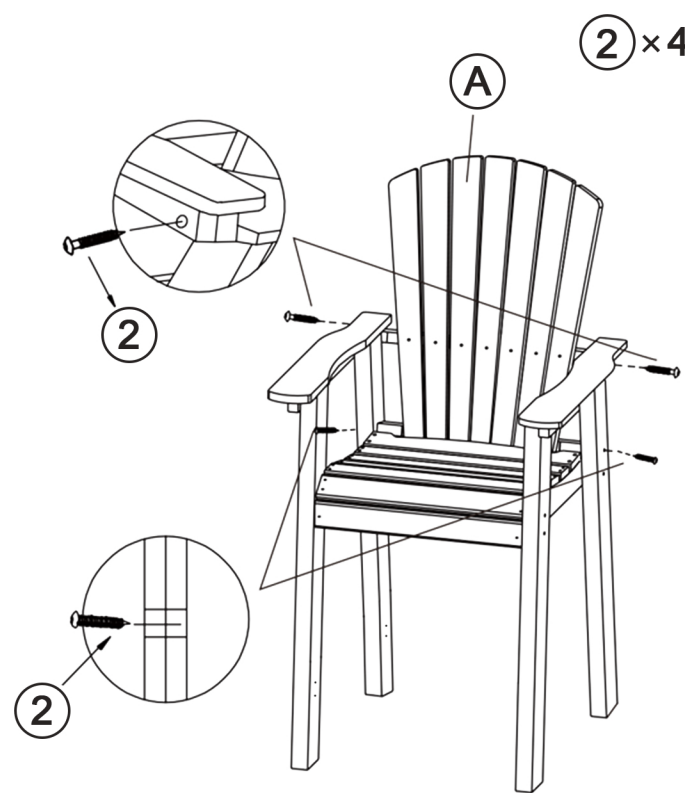

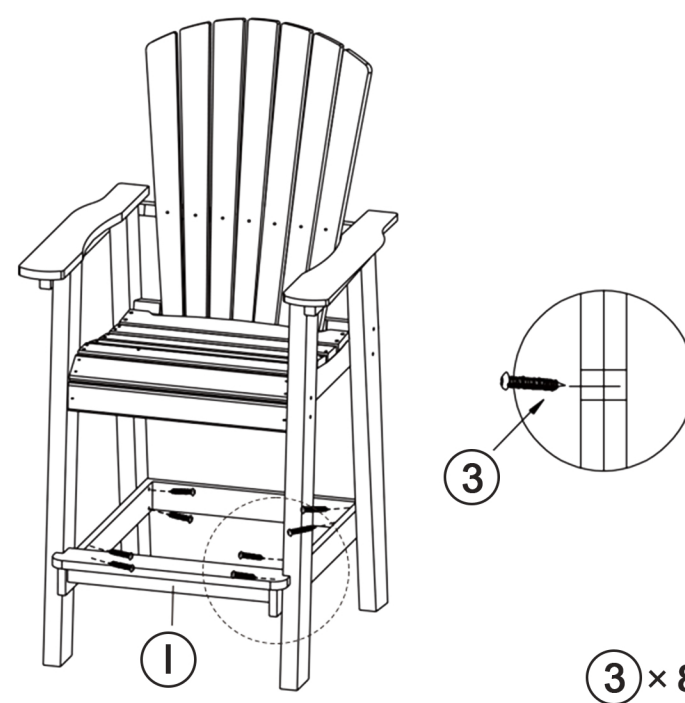

STEP 3

Attach "Chair Back (A)" to "Chair Arms (G/H)" - Using "2 M6 x 80MM Bolts", tighten with hex key.

Attach "Chair Back (A)" to "Rear Legs (E/F)" - Using "2 M6 x 80MM Bolts", tighten with hex key.



STEP 4

Attach "Box Stretchers (I)" to Legs (C/D/E/F)" - Using "3 M6 x 50MM Bolts", tighten with hex key.

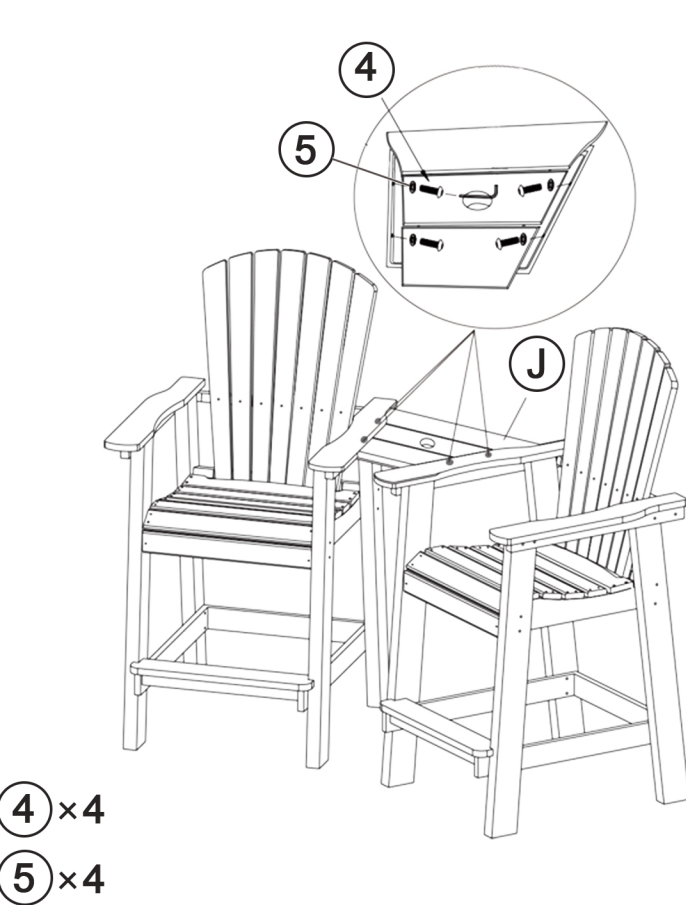
Repeat the step 1 to step 4 to assemble the second bar chair.

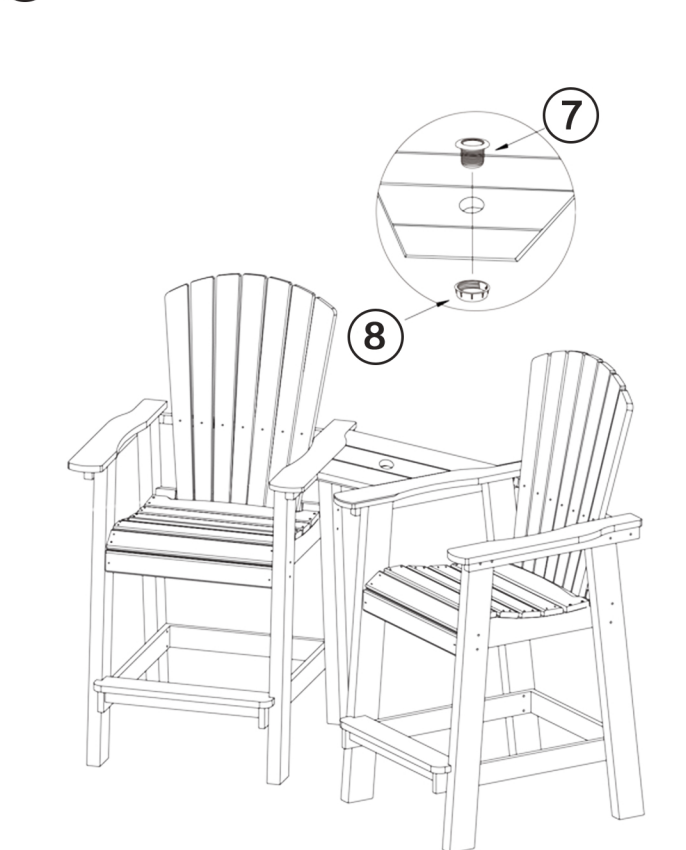

STEP 5

Attach "Connecting Table (J)" to "Chair Arms" to connect 2 bar chairs - Using "4 M6 x 30MM Bolts & Washer", tighten with hex key.

The convenient connecting table can be detached at any time if you wish to move the Adirondacks bar chairs.base.



STEP 6

Using the "7 and 8" to seal the hole on "Connecting Table (J)" - This is an umbrella hole suitable for most of patio umbrella, you could unseal it to attach patio umbrella.

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

Check you have all the components and tools listed on the page 2.

Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts may cause choking if swallowed.

Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same area) as possible.

Do not place furniture directly in front of radiators, fires, or any other source of heat.



The assembly will be easier with 2 people while 1 person could also do the job.

Cleaning & Maintenance

Clean the product with a solution of mild soap and water. Dip a soft cloth or sponge into the solution and wipe down the entire surface.

After cleaning, thoroughly rinse the furniture with water to remove any remaining soap residue.

When not in use, cover the product with a protective cover to keep it clean and prolong its lifespan.
