PREPARATION

Before beginning assembly of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and hardware contents list. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product.

Estimated Assembly Time: 30 minutes (with recommended two-person installation). Tools Required for Assembly (not included): Measuring tape, Level, Phillips screwdriver, Stud finder.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1a. For drywall installations: Install bottom bracket (F) a minimum of 3 inches above your existing faucet/ vanity by inserting two long screws (GG) through bottom bracket (F) and directly into wall studs. Note: Ensure the marks are level before proceeding.

1b. For solid wall installations: Using bottom bracket (F) as a guide, mark screw locations with a pencil (not included) a minimum of 3 inches above your existing faucet/vanity. Use a 5/16-in. drill bit (not included) and drill a pilot hole at marked locations. Insert wall anchors (HH) into holes, then insert long screws (GG) through bottom bracket (F) and into wall anchors (HH).

2. Carefully position the cabinet (C) onto the bottom bracket (F) and hold in place.

3a. For drywall installations: With the assistance of another person, install the top clips (II) by inserting the rounded ends into the rear top slot of cabinet (C).Slide one top clip (II) to the left and one to the right, then secure using long screws (GG) through the top clips (II) and directly into the wall studs.

3b. For solid wall installations: With the assistance of another person, install the top clips (II) by inserting the rounded ends into the rear top slot of cabinet (C) Slide one top clip (II) to the left and one to the right, then mark locations with a pencil. Temporarily move top clips (II) out of position, then use a 5/16-in. drill bit (not included) and drill a pilot hole at marked locations. Move top clips (II) back into position and insert wall anchors (HH) into holes, then insert long screws (GG) through top clip (II) and into wall anchors (HH).

4. Attach side mirror brackets (JJ) to cabinet (C) where shown (on both sides) with short screws (AA) and washers (EE), then snap caps (DD) to cover the screw heads.

5. Remove the paper from the preassembled adhesive tape on each side mirror bracket (JJ), then carefully attach side mirrors (B) to each side of cabinet (C).

6. Install the glass shelves (E) to the desired positions with shelf clips (BB), making sure they are level.

8. Stick the bumpers (FF) at the two corners of the door (D) opposite the door hinges (A).

9. To power the item, either insert 3 C batteries (not included) into each battery compartment on the bottom of cabinet (C) or insert the adapter (KK) into the DC jack at the bottom of cabinet (C), plugging the other end

POWER:

1. Off mode: Clock and night light will be OFF; clock is still operational, though it can be reset in this mode, too.

2. On mode: Clock and night light are both ON.

CLOCK:

To set the clock, hold the CLOCK SET key on the door (D) for 3 seconds; the time will flash to indicate the clock is in setting mode. Simply push the HOUR key and MINUTE key to adjust the time as needed, then press the CLOCK SET key again to exit the setting mode.

Note: If power to the item is interrupted (and there are no batteries installed), both the clock and alarm (if applicable) will need reset.

ALARM:

To set the alarm, hold the ALARM key on the door (D) for 3 seconds; the alarm symbol will flash and the item will buzz two times to indicate the alarm is in setting mode. Simply push the HOUR key and MINUTE key to set the desired alarm time, then press the ALARM key again to exit the setting mode.

Note: Pushing the ALARM key will activate or cancel the alarm once set. If the alarm is on, the clock will automatically be displayed and the alarm symbol will be lit up; if the alarm is off, the symbol will not appear.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Use a household liquid glass cleaner to keep the mirror and glass surfaces clean.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners containing ammonia.
