

## Safety Rules



#### **INSTALLATION & OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS GENERAL**


Before starting the installation, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the appropriate fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (NEC) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections, obtain the services of a qualified electrician.


## 2. Packing List



#### NOTE:


- 1. Crystal is fragile; spare parts are included.
- 2. Some parts may be placed inside the canopy. Please ensure you remove all items from the box to check against the packing list.

## 3. Mounting and Wiring



#### 1. Mount the Bracket


Take off screws from outlet box (A). Secure the mounting plate (B) onto the box with screws (C) taken off (Fig. 1).



#### 2. Connect the Wires

Step 1: Press the wire locker and adjust the hanging wire to achieve the desired height (see Fig. 4).

Step 2: Connect the fixture wires (E) to the house wires (G). Connect black or brown to the live wire, white or blue to the neutral wire, and green/bare copper/yellow and green wire to the ground wire. Wrap each connection with electrical tape (H).




#### 3. Fix the Canopy

Fix the canopy (I) onto the (B) with nut (J) provided (Fig. 3).

#### 4. Adjust the Balance

Adjust the wire length by pressing the wire locker on the canopy to get it level (Fig. 4).





To shorten the line length, push the line directly. To extend it, press the movable plug.




To increase the length of the line, pull the line outward.

#### **Wire Locker Adjustment Details**

To shorten the hanging wire, directly push it in.

To extend the hanging wire, press the movable plug on the tension head and then pull out the cable, as illustrated in the figure below.

## 4. Fixture Assembly



Stp1: Unpack the packaging and take out the crystal strings.

Stp2: Manually manipulate the branches, bending and positioning them until they match the configuration illustrated in the figure provided.

Stp3: Install the bulbs (G9 x 9, Max 7W each, LED recommended).

Stp4: Hang the crystal strings on to the branches.

P.S: Gently lower the crystal ball to avoid hook tangling.

## **Trouble Shooting**

#### 1. Missing or Broken Parts

 Make a list of the missing/broken parts according to the packing list, take photos for broken parts, then email us for free replacements.

#### 2. Bulbs Do Not Light Up, Flicker, or Operate Noisily

- Ensure that the power is on and the switch is operational.
- Verify that the bulb is installed correctly.
- Replace the bulb with a new one.
- Inspect the wires to ensure they are properly connected.
- If using a dimmer switch, confirm that the bulb is compatible with dimming features.

#### 3. Installation Issues

Photograph the ceiling and contact the seller for technical support.

### Clean and Care

- 1. Ensure that the power is turned off and the bulb has cooled before handling.
- 2. Wipe clean with a dry cloth or a mild soapy solution. Do not use corrosive cleaners.

## **Ordering Parts**

Keep this manual for future reference, and in case replacement parts are needed. Available parts can be ordered from place of purchase. Use exact wording from diagrams when ordering parts.
