

Gather the necessary tools as shown below to complete the installation of this faucet. Some may not be needed depending on the model of faucet you are installing.






## **Preparation / Mounting**



- 1. Shut off water supply and drain lines. Clean sink surface thoroughly. Make sure mounting area is clean and dry.
- 2. Remove the plastic locknut ②4 from faucet.

  Don't remove the putty plate ②3 from faucet.


## **Faucet Installation**



3. Position the faucet on the countertop with putty plate ②3. Replace the plastic locknuts ②4 on the faucet tailpiece ②7 and tighten the plastic locknuts ②4 by hand.

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## Configuration



Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8" O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8" Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (½")



Warning:

The supply valve and supply lines are not included.



#### Important:

Let both hot and cold water run for one minute.

This will help clean any debris that might clog the system.

Test system for leaks.
