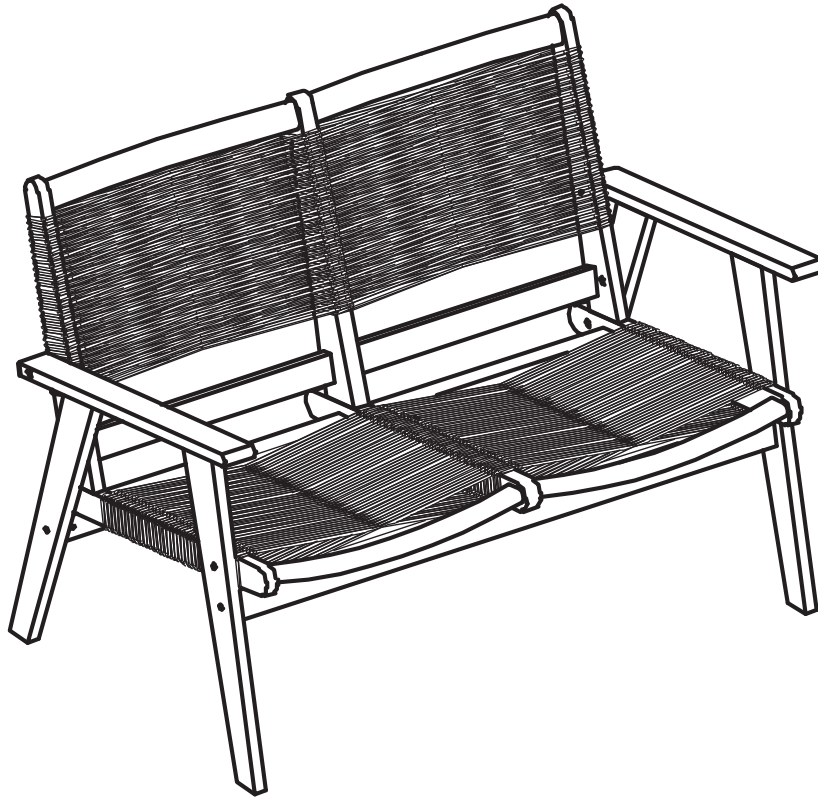

Before beginning assembly, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts received with the parts list. If any part is missing or damaged, do NOT attempt to assemble the product. Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate or install this product. If you have any questions regarding the product, please contact Customer Service.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Your new Kingsmen Loveseat Bench is made from the finest materials available. It should provide many years of enjoyment with minimal care.

Keep your Kingsmen Loveseat Bench clean. For best results, clean with a soft, damp cloth. If you use furniture covers, always make sure the Kingsmen Loveseat Bench is clean and completely dry before covering, as mold may form in dark, wet places. Remove any cushions prior to covering and store separately. Check the hardware on your Kingsmen Loveseat Bench regularly to make sure it is secure.

The weight limit is 650 LB /300 KG.

WARNING

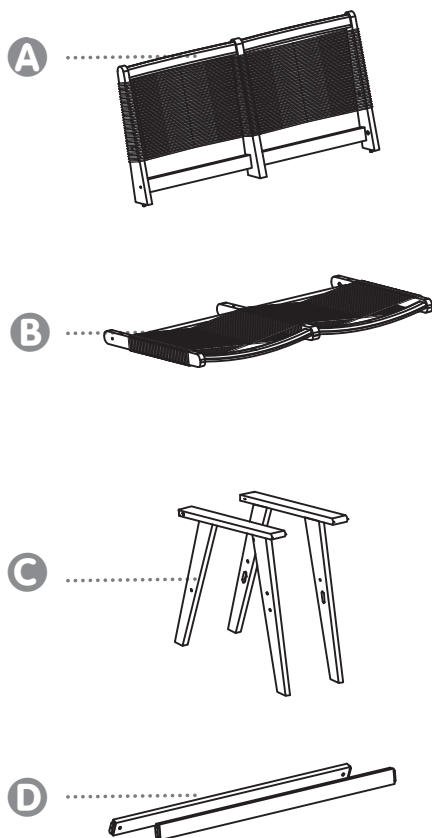
Do not stand or allow children to stand on the assembled product. Ensure hardware is securely in place. Perform periodic checks to make sure the connections are secure and adjust if needed.

CAUTION

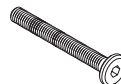

You will also need a screwdriver with a medium blade (not included).

TIP: Assembly of this item involves *Mortise and Tenon Joints*. A *Mortise* is a notch or hole in a piece of wood designed to receive a *Tenon* of corresponding dimensions.

NOTE: Assemble in a clear area on a spacious, nonabrasive surface such as a carpet or blanket. **Do NOT over-tighten hardware, or you risk stressing or cracking the wood.**

As you proceed through assembly, be sure to insert each Bolt **STRAIGHT** into the receiving hardware or threaded hole. **Insertion at an angle can strip the threads and prevent secure connections.**

Do NOT fully tighten any hardware connection until the entire bench is assembled. Then, go back and fully tighten each bolt.

1 Begin by assembling the frame, consisting of the **Left/Right Sides C** and the **Cross Bars D**. (It may be easier to attach both **Cross Bars** to one **Side**, then connect the second **Side** to both **Cross Bars**.)

Insert a **Barrel Nut G** into each of the holes drilled in the flat sides of the **Cross Bars**, near each end. Use a screwdriver to rotate the **Barrel Nuts** so the threaded holes in the sides of the **Barrel Nuts** line up with the holes drilled in the ends of the **Cross Bars**.

Insert the tenon of one **Cross Bar** into the oblong mortise in the first **Side**. (Orient the **Cross Bar** so the holes with the

Barrel Nuts face in—toward each other—when both **Cross Bars** are installed.) Insert a **Bolt F** through one leg of the **Side** and into the hole in the end of the **Cross Bar**. Use a **Hex Wrench** to gently tighten the **Bolt** into the **Barrel Nut** to secure, being careful not to over-tighten. Repeat this process with the second leg and **Cross Bar**.

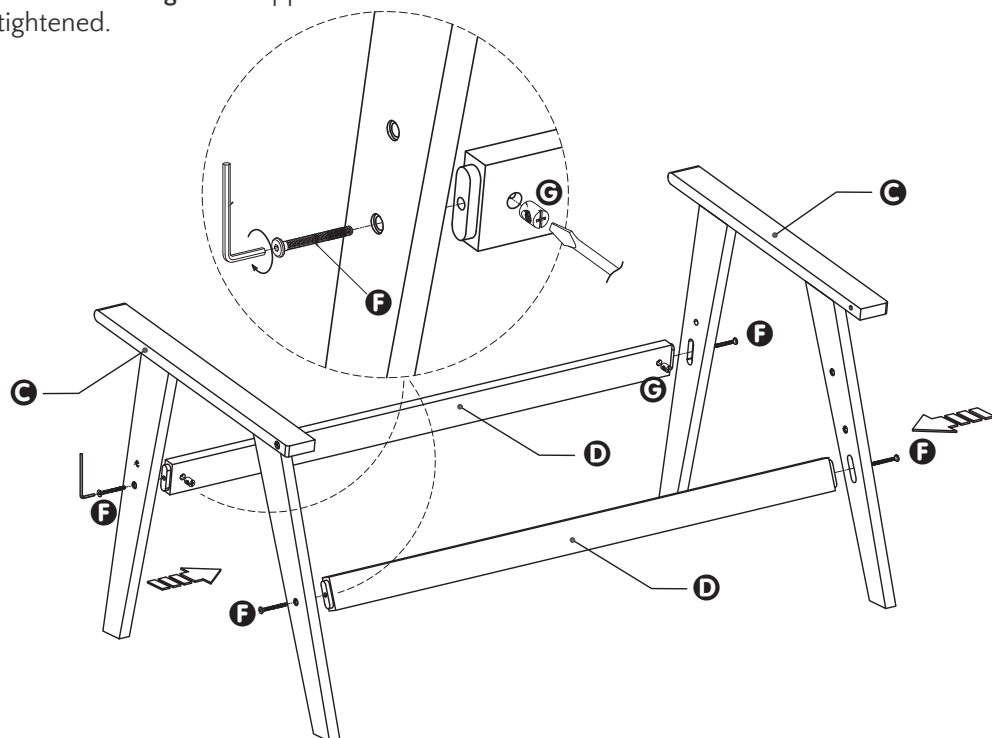
Use the method above to attach the second **Leg** to the opposite ends of the **Cross Bars**. Check that all hardware is temporarily secure, but not fully tightened.

G Barrel Nut x4



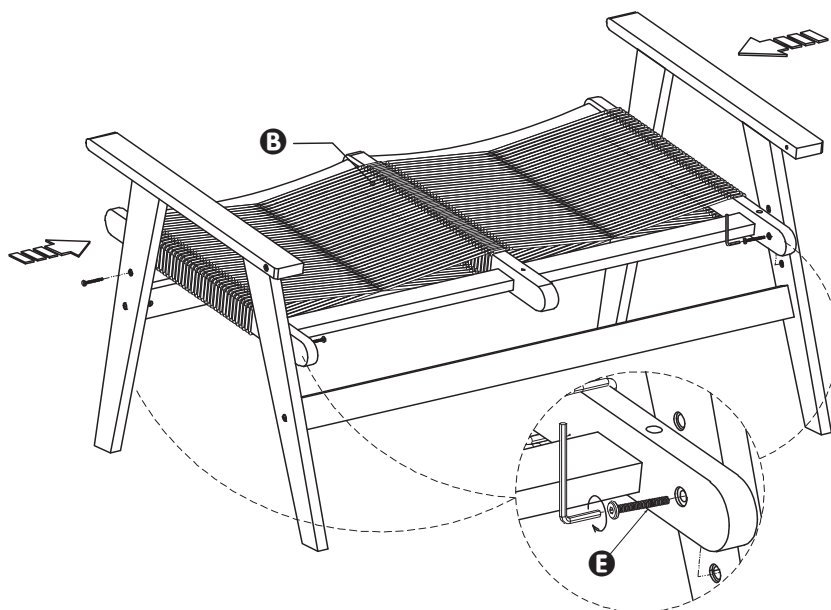
2 Identify the front of the bench frame by finding the rounded ends of the arms. The *front* of the **Seat** has curved cross bars, and the *back* has flat cross bars.

Install the **Seat** by aligning the holes drilled near the back ends of both side/edge pieces with the lower holes drilled into the insides of the back legs. Insert a **Bolt E** into each of the aligned holes and finger-tighten gently. Then, align the holes near the front ends of the side/edge pieces and insert a **Bolt E** through each front leg and into the **Seat**.

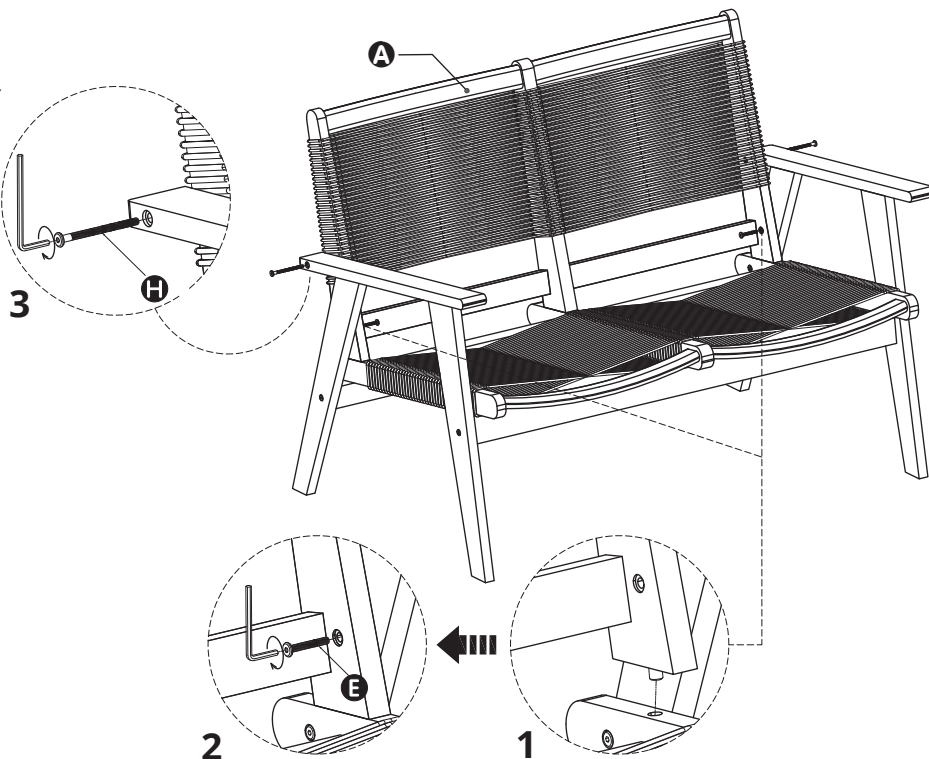


Hardware Used:

E Bolt (M6x40) x4



3 To install the **Backrest A**, insert the tenons at the bottom of each end of the **Back** into the mortises in the top of the back end of the edge pieces of the seat. Secure by inserting a **Bolt E** through the hole near the bottom of either side of the **Backrest** and into each bench **Side**. Then insert a **Bolt H** through the hole drilled at the back of each arm and into the aligned hole at each side of the **Back**. Finger-tighten each Bolt.

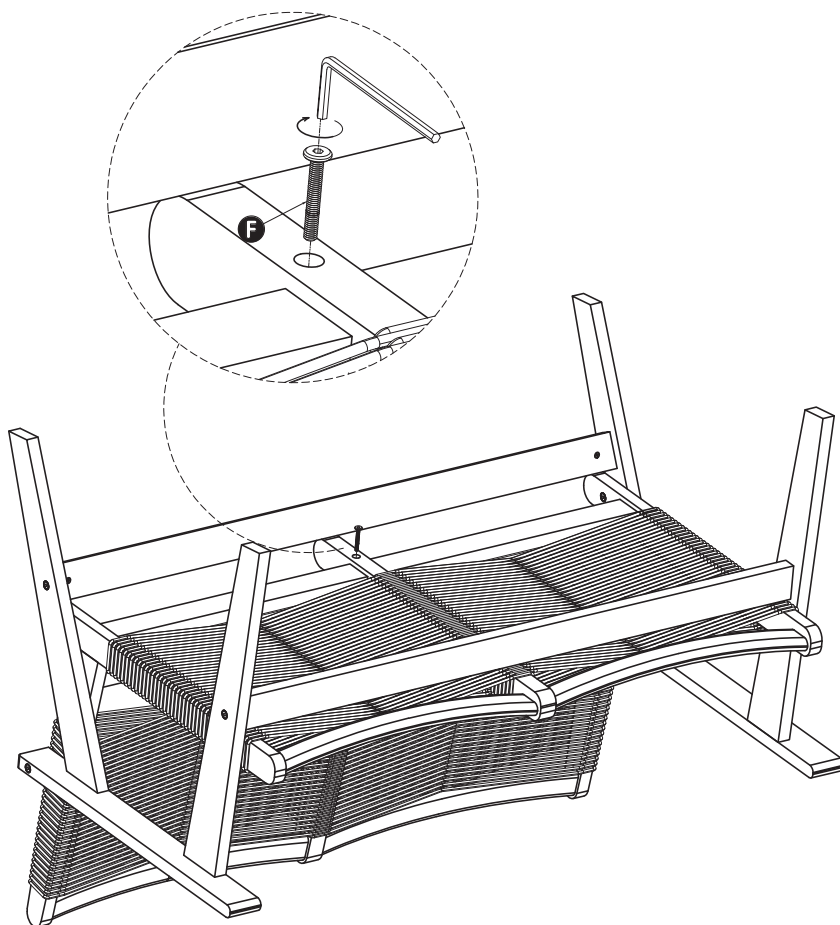
H Bolt (M6x80) x2

4 On a nonabrasive surface, carefully turn the bench upside-down. Locate the hole near the back end of the seat divider.

Insert 1 **Bolt F** to join the **Seat** to the **Backrest**. Tighten the **Bolt** using the **Hex Wrench**, being careful not to over-tighten.

Turn the bench back upright. Proceed to fully tighten all installed hardware, being careful not to over-tighten.

Your Kingsmen Loveseat Bench is fully assembled!

Be sure to have your sales receipt, date of purchase and catalogue/model numbers available when calling. All warranty service will be coordinated by Balkene Home's Amelia Island, Florida service center. This warranty is extended only to the original owner. Proof of purchase will be required before warranty service is rendered. The sales receipt is the only valid proof of purchase. This warranty only covers failures due to defects in materials or workmanship which occur during normal use. Failures and/or damage which result from accident, negligence, misuse, abuse, neglect, mishandling, alteration or modification, failure to maintain, improper assembly or maintenance, service by unauthorized agency or use of unauthorized components or damage that is attributable to acts of God are NOT covered.

This limited warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.
