
Assembly Steps



This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise youself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




Place the two halves of the Table Top together on a flat surface. Align the bolt holes of the 2 Side Connect Bars (H) and Middle Connect Bar (I) with the Table Top (A), Note that the grooves on the 3 connecting bars must lie in a straight line. Install the 12 Bolts (1) with 12 Spring Washers (3) and 12 Flat Washers (4) through the mounting positions using Allen Wrench (7), as shown above picture.

Fully tighten the Bolts.



Continue to place the Bottom Middle Bar (K) into the correct grooves, align the bolt holes. Install the 6 Bolts (1) with 6 Spring Washers (3) and 6 Flat Washers (4) through the mounting positions using Allen Wrench (7), as shown above picture.


Fully tighten the Bolts.



Install the legs together.


The First Leg (B) will be attached to the Second Leg (C) and the Third leg (D) will be attached to the Fourht Leg (E) with a 2 Bolts (1) using a Allen Wrench (7), as shown above picture.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.




Place the two pairs of legs install in step 4 together to match the grooves. Align the bolt holes of the Upper Cross Block (F) and 4 Legs. Install the 4 Screws (6) through the mounting positions using Allen Wrench (7), as shown above picture.

Do not fully tighten the Screws.



Rotate the foot assembly up for easy installation of the Lower Cross Block (G). Same as step 5, Install the 4 Screws (6) through the mounting positions using Allen Wrench (7), as shown above picture.


Do not fully tighten the Screws.



Place the leg assembly installed in step 6 onto the table top installed in step 3, align the bolt holes.

Install the 4 Bolts (1) with 4 Sleeve Nuts (5) through the mounting positions using 2 Allen Wrench (7), as shown above picture.

Fully tighten the Bolts.



Stand the Table up, with assistance from your adult partner. Exert pressure floorwards, onto the Table with both your hands. This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status. Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface. If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured. When tightening the Bolts tighten sequentially. Do not tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one. If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts and excute the same above process.

Your Table is ready for use. This Table can only be used on the flat, level surface.
