## Petunia



### LIGHT

Petunias thrive in an open spot that receives at least 6 to 8 hours of direct sun a day.



### WATER

Petunia likes to be watered regularly, keeping the soil evenly moist.



### FOOD

Feed me once or twice a year during Spring and Summer with a fertilizer formulated for houseplants.



### FEATURES

Hummingbirds and a plethora of pollinating insects will also flock to your garden to feast on the nectar-rich blooms.

### GROWING TIPS

The plants like a loose, rich, slightly moist soil. If you are growing petunias in containers, plant them in a commercial potting soil mix.
