





- 1.Remove all components from the strainer body.
- 2. Apply a small amount of putty evenly around the top hole in the sink, approximately 1/2" from the opening.
- 3. Insert the basket strainer into the sink opening. Slip the rubber and paper washers up to the sink. Thread and tighten the lock nut onto the washers.
- 4. Place the poly washer on the tailpiece extension. Connect the tailpiece to the strainer with the slip nut. Tighten it securely to the strainer. Test for leaks by running water.
