What's in the box?



- 1 **A24 Rat and Mouse Trap** - with self-resetting captive bolt
 - 2 **Trap Shroud** - protects your chosen lure from theft
 - 3 **Trap Mount** - attaches trap to tree or post outdoors
 - 4 **2 x Co2 Canisters** - each powering 24 auto-kills and resets
 - 5 **Lure Basket** - fill with your choice of lure
- + **Quick Start Guide** - gets you set up in minutes



How the Starter Trap Kit works


1. Sniff

Non-toxic paste attracts rodents into the trap.




2. Kapow!

Rodent moves the trigger to get to the paste, firing the trap.



3. Self-reset

The trap clears and resets immediately after an A-Class humane kill.




4. Sniff

Paste continues to attract pests for 6 months.


How the Lure Basket works



What is the Lure Basket?

The Lure Basket is perfect if you want a more hands-on approach to the classic Automatic Paste Pump, as it allows you to use the attractant of your choice. Some people successfully use classic peanut butter, nutella, sunflower seeds, nuts... whatever your local pests are fond of.

This can be useful if you're faced with strong food competition, whether it be pet food in the kitchen or grain storage on farm, as you can use foods that your rodents have become accustomed to.



How to install the Lure Basket?

Simply screw the lure basket into the top of the trap, where you would normally install the automatic paste pump, fill it with the lure of your choice and screw the cap on top to cover it.

It's easy to fill, empty and clean. Don't forget to check and replace the contents regularly to prevent your attractant from going mouldy. Our bait basket is made from high-quality 100% recycled plastic, designed to stand the test of time in nature's harsh outdoor conditions.

Upgradeable with a wide range of additional accessories.



Trap Stand

Perfect if trapping in hard-to-reach places, or want the flexibility to move their trap.

Gas Canister

Early on, we discovered that not all gas canisters are made equal.

We tested dozens from different makers around the world before choosing the highest possible quality made of recyclable steel and a dab of silicone to keep your trap running smoothly.




Pre-Feed Pouches

Every successful Goodnature trapper has a pouch of pre-feed paste in their trapping toolkit.

It gets rats and mice used to the smell and taste of our Nut Butter paste, and once the pre-feed is gone, they'll follow their noses up into the trap and KAPOW!


Trap Mount Installation

The Goodnature Trap Mount allows you to use and secure your trap outdoors in rural and conservation areas by attaching it to a tree, post or building using two included screws. Having an extra Trap Mount up your sleeve will make it easier for you to move your A24 trap between different locations.



Attach the Trap Mount

Screw the Trap Mount 12 cm (about a hand's width) above ground or at 1.2m if you have weka in the area.



Power up the trap

Screw in the Gas Canister to power your trap for up to 6 months. **The Trap is now live!**



Make it attractive

Activate & push the Automatic Paste Pump into the cap, remove the lid and screw onto the Trap. **Pre-feed to increase your chances!**

Customer Success Tips

Success Tip #1

Assess (don't guess) to find out where rodents feel safest to eat.




Rodents are naturally cautious, and where you've seen one isn't necessarily where they feel safe to stop and eat. So don't guess but assess the best spots to install your trap by following these simple steps. Once you've identified the spots they feel safe enough to eat, the chances of them putting their heads up into a Goodnature trap significantly increase.



Identify locations

Try lures in varied spots for a couple of days, then check interactions in the morning. Use their favorite pantry food or Goodnature pre-feed paste, trap location cards are available as accessories.



Install your trap

After identifying a good spot, install your trap without setting it live. Pre-feed with small amounts of their favorite lure under & around the trap, making it their safe eating spot.




Set your trap live


After 1-2 weeks, stop pre-feeding, fill your Lure Basket, and set your trap live. Now, the only way for rodents to access their new favorite food is to poke their heads in.

Trap Locations on a farm





Success Tip #2

Remove other food sources

Rodents don't tend to move in unless there's a safe reliable food source, like a compost bin or animal food.

And because they're afraid of new things once they've got a safe reliable food source, they tend to ignore others - including new traps.

We encourage people to contain competing food sources, even just for that first week or two, so rodents have a reason to take a risk and go in search of a new food source, up inside the trap.
