


 $6. \mbox{Drill}$ holes in the marked locations and insert wall anchors (G). (NOTE: A wall anchor is not necessary if the screw will be going directly into a stud.) 0 0 0 NOTE: Use a 1/4 in. (6mm) drill bit for drywall anchor installation. Use a 5/64 in. (2mm) drill bit for direct stud installation. If installing into a material other than drywall or into stud, consult a professional for proper installation.


7. Making sure the end cap (C) is in the upright position with the screw hole closest to the wall (in the neck of the endcap) is on top, fasten the endcap (C) to the side wall.

NOTE: Screw hole closest to the wall in the "neck" of the endcap is on top, as shown.

Repeat for the other end cap (C).



8. Then fasten the tube asembly to the endcaps (C) using allen wrench (H), as shown.
