


Face the logo to the front


Insert the faucet through sink


Screw the nut onto the connecting pipe body


Tighten fitting nuts with adjustable wrench

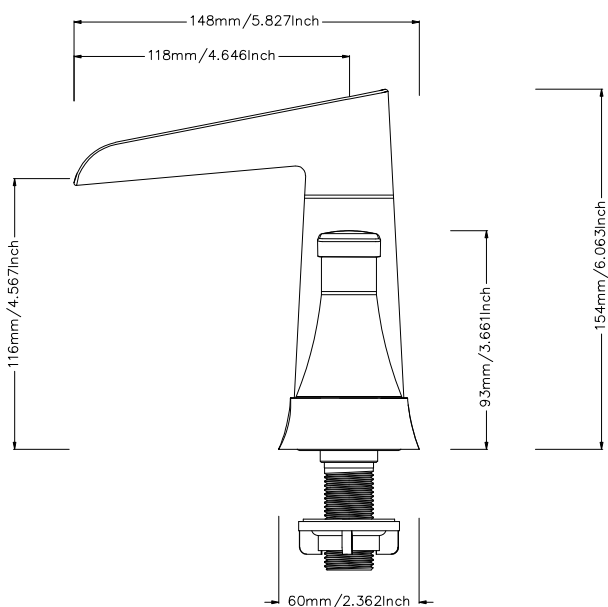
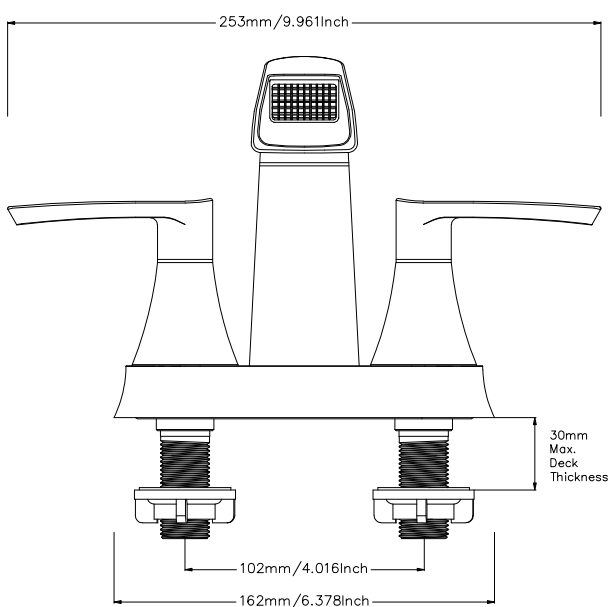


Connect and tighten the supply hoses

Turn on the water supplies. Check all connections for leaks




Pop-up Drain with Overflow Installation Guide




NOTES:


- Fits for sink WITH overflow hole.
- Clean the sink hole, make sure to remove debris.
- Please avoid using plumber's putty. The seal on top is leak-free. Plumber's putty might cause damage.
- Silicone and plumbing tape can be use for sealing requirement.




1 Unscrew components A & B to the seal.




2 Slide the drain body C through the hole in the sink.



3 Screw components A & B back on as shown.



4 Connect the rear end of the drain to the Drain Pipe.



5 Push to activate.
