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

Product Care and Maintenance	
<p>Caution</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This appliance may only be repaired by a service center designated by the manufacturer. Users cannot disassemble or repair it by themselves. • Remember to turn off the main power switch after use. • Do not use this product if the power socket becomes loose. • If this product will be left unused for a long period of time, it is necessary to roll up the power cord of this product and store this product in a dry and dust-free environment. • Do not store this product at a high temperature or near open flame. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunshine. • Please clean this product with dry cloth. Never use thinner, benzene or alcohol. • The mechanism of this appliance were specially designed and manufactured and don't require special maintenance. • Do not use a sharp object to stab at this product. • Do not roll or pull this product on any uneven ground. Calf installation instructions

1. After connecting the wires and the air hose between the legrest and the massage chair, remove the cable ties and insert the connecting part into the seat (Figure 1).
2. Place the round tubes on the left and right sides of the legrest onto the legrest support (Figure 2).



3. Next, turn the legrest fixing cover over to cover the round tubes on both sides of the legrest (Figure 3).
4. Fasten the legrest to the massage chair with two M4 screws (one on each side). Check whether there is any abnormality during turning up and down, or any tube, cable or wire is folded. If everything is OK, the legrest is installed (Figure 4).




Place massage chair

Installation placement

Make sure there is enough space for the massage chair can be tilted at least 10 cm.


Do not expose the massage chair directly to high temperature environment due to sunlight (such as: in front of heating equipment), and place it to where can avoid high temperature and direct sunlight. It is recommended to lay a soft cushion for long-term use in a designated location. When laying the cushion, the size of the cushion should be enough to cover. Keep the range where the machine touches the floor and the range where your feet touch the floor.



Product lift instruction

Require team work to lift and move the chair to avoid injury.

1. Please lift the massage chair to move it on vulnerable ground such as wooden floor.
2. When moving on a similar wooden floor, it is recommended to lift it. Avoid damage to the casters. When the floor is lifted and moved to the designated position, be careful to keep your hands out of the way to avoid injury, and be careful of your feet being crushed. Do not let go of the unit until the unit is completely flat, the floor may be damaged, therefore, it is recommended to place mats, etc. on the floor.




Place massage chair

Move method

Use the rear casters to move the massage chair. Move the chair by tilting it down and backward about 45° as shown in the diagram.



NOTE: Excessive force to tilt will cause the chair to tip over completely and product damage.

1. Before moving, please shut down the machine properly to reset the whole machine, and then cut off the power.
2. Please keep the chair vacant when moving. (People, pets or clutter will not be able to stay on the chair.)
3. When moving, do not cross a drop barrier higher than 2mm or a gap greater than 5mm.
4. When using casters to move this product, single continuous movement is not supported; if the distance exceeds 50 meters, please make this product move slowly and evenly.



How to disassemble and use headrest cushion and backrest cushion


Using a headrest cushion can reduce the intensity of kneading massage on the neck and shoulders, and you can decide whether to use a headrest cushion according to your needs (recommended to use a headrest cushion). The backrest cushion and the backrest are connected by a zipper (1), and the headrest cushion and the backrest cushion are connected by a zipper (2).


Check around

Make sure that there are no people, pets and other objects around the unit.



Make sure there are no foreign objects in the gaps of the machine


Before massaging, make sure that no foreign objects are caught in the legs, feet, etc.
Under no circumstances allow hands, feet, and head to penetrate into the area between the lower leg mechanism and main body, or the area between the armrest and the capsule.
Under no circumstances should hands, feet, or head sink under the fabric or leather covering of the massage area.







2 Schematic diagram of power on




3 Turn on the power switch ("I" position)







- 1.LCD:
 - Display all massage functions.
- 2.Power switch:
 - Turn on or off all massage functions.
- 3.Pause/start key:
 - Pause or run all massage functions.
- 4.Timing key:
 - Timing adjustment.
- 5Automatic lying key:
 - There are three automatic lying modes, which can automatically switch according to your own needs.
- 6.Legrest up key:
 - Adjust the legrest up function.
- 7Automatic massage key:
 - Please refer to Page 11 of this manual for details.
- 8.Air pressure mode key:
 - Turn on/off air pressure massage function. (Please refer to Page 12 of this manual for details.)
- 9.Manual massage key:

2.Introduction to Armrest Shortcut Keys

Left armrest




- 1. ON/OFF Key: Short press this key to turn ON/OFF the massage.
- 2. Legrest Up/Down key: press it to make the legrest move upward/downward.
- 3. AUTO Key: press it to switch the automatic massage function.
- 4. Backrest adjustment key: the back rest keeping lifting or recline.
- 5. Zero Gravity Key: short press to adjust the angle of Zero Gravity; Long press for 3 seconds to turn on or off the voice control mode.

Product structure

Function	Description
	Power button: press it to turn on or off all massage functions.
	Backrest up: the back rest keeping lifting when pressing this key, and black rest stopped lifting once release the key.
	Backrest down key: the back rest keeping reclining when lift this key, and black rest stopped reclining once release the key.
	Zero-gravity key: After this key is pressed, the positions of the legrest and the backrest can be automatically adjusted to the positions for zero gravity. There are three levels of zero-gravity modes, which can be switched. Long press for 3 seconds to turn on or off the voice control mode.
	Legrest up button: Pull the button to make the legrest rise slowly. Release it to stop such action.
	Legrest down button: Press the button to make the legrest move downward slowly. Release it to stop such action.
AUTO	Automatic mode key: Press it to switch among those automatic massage functions.





Right armrest



3.Start massage

- ①.Press the power button to start the massage, the default is relax massage.
- ②.Automatic angle adjustment (you can press any key to skip)
- ③.Automatic human shoulder position detection, keep the sitting posture fit with the massage chair (you can press any key to skip).
- ④.Shoulder position fine-tuning, if the detected position deviates from the actual shoulder position, adjust it to the appropriate position through the up and down key of the shoulder position (or you can press any key to skip), there are 11 shoulder positions in total. If there is no adjustment within 10 seconds, it will enter into the massage function.
Note: Automatic function can be selected during startup. Repeated selection of the same automatic function can skip the startup process and directly massage.

During the detection of shoulder position and massage finger pressure point (the hand controller screen displays the shoulder position adjustment icon and hears the "Didi" of the hand controller. At the same time, press the up and down buttons of the shoulder position to adjust the shoulder position).





Pause/start		Press this button during massage, and all the massage actions will be suspended at once (i.e. the massage chair will turn off after 20min). Then press this button again to restore all the previous massage actions.	

• Lying angle adjustment

Function	Button	Description
Up key		Press this button. The backrest will slowly rise, and the legrest will slowly move downward. Beeps can be heard until it reaches the top. Press this button again during sitting up. Such action will stop immediately.
Lying key		Press this button. The backrest will slowly move downward, and the legrest will slowly rise. Beeps can be heard until it reaches the bottom. Press this button again during lying. Such action will stop immediately.
Legrest up		Press this button. The legrest will slowly rise. Beeps can be heard until it reaches the top. Release this button to stop adjustment.
Legrest down		Press this button. The legrest will slowly move downward. Beeps can be heard until it reaches the bottom. Release this button to stop adjustment.

4.Voice Control Mode

- When the massage chair is turned on or in standby mode, the sound "Hi Alice" or "Hey Alice" will be produced to enable the voice control function.
- Press at least 3 seconds zero-gravity key on the armrest (on/off Voice Control mode).
- After such function is enabled successfully, the massage chair will reply "I am here". At this moment, once a corresponding voice control entry to be implemented is given within six seconds, the corresponding voice control function can be performed after a reply is received from the massage chair; if no correct voice control entry is given within six seconds, the voice control function automatically will be off automatically and needs to be enabled again.
- Note: When using the voice control function, the speech speed should not be too fast, and the voice commands should be issued according to the voice control entries. After each successful use of the voice-activated entry, it is recommended to give out the voice command after 1-2 seconds.



5.Operation Instructions for Bluetooth Speaker Play


- Enter the smart device main menu. Open "Settings" and select the "Bluetooth" option. Open "Bluetooth", and Bluetooth will automatically "Search for a New Bluetooth Device".
- The smart device will search for the corresponding Bluetooth model (e.g. IMCM-XXXX). Click the "Match" button. If you are asked whether to match with the device, you just select "Match" to complete matching.
- Turn on "Music Player" in the smart device and select the song to play.


- During the massage process, press the power key off remote to immediately turn off all massage functions, the backrest and leg rest will reset, or when the massage time expires, it will automatically turn off all massage functions, but the backrest and leg rest will not reset.
- Shut off the power supply of this product, as shown in the attached figure (Power Shut-off Diagram of the Product).

Cleaning and Maintenance

Cleaning synthetic leather and plastic parts

Wipe the leather with a soft, dry cloth.

- Do not use chemicals such as thinner, gasoline, alcohol, etc. to clean the unit.
- When using commercially available leather care products (rags), please follow the instructions for use.
- If the PU leather is particularly dirty, wipe it by the following methods.
 - ① Immerse a soft cloth in water or hot water containing 3% to 5% neutral detergent, then wring it out thoroughly.
 - ② Use the above soft cloth to wipe the leather surface.
 - ③ Wipe off the cleaning solution with a cloth soaked in clean water and thoroughly wrung out.
 - ④ Wipe with a wrung soft cloth.
 - ⑤ Let it air dry naturally.
- When it is difficult to remove stains, please immerse commercially available melamine foam in neutral detergent, and then wipe the machine with it.
- Do not use a hair dryer to dry the surface.
- As the color of the fabric will stain the surface of the PU leather, be careful when wiping the chair with denim and colored fabrics.
- Do not keep these parts in contact with plastic for a long time, as this will cause discoloration.
- PU leather may be discolored, so when using hair dye, please cover the touched part with a towel.



Troubleshooting

Fault	When the calf mechanism or the backrest reaches a certain position, press the corresponding adjustment button and it will no longer change, and a continuous "beep, beep" sound will be emitted.
Solution	Due to product structure design and ergonomic requirements, this product has a limited protection design for the limit state of attitude adjustment. At the same time, a reminder sound will sound when the limit is reached.

Fault	The function does not work or some functions do not work after the machine is turned on.
Solution	After the machine is turned on by pressing the switch key, it is necessary to manually select an automatic massage program or other working state. If it is not operated, the machine will automatically shut down after 20 minutes. If the manual operation mode is selected, the functions that are not selected may be disabled, and the working mode needs to be manually set in the manual mode.

Fault	The machine makes a leather rubbing sound when adjusting its posture.
Solution	This product adopts high-grade anti-corrosion leather that meets environmental protection requirements. Due to the inherent characteristics of leather materials, there will be a normal slight noise when rubbing at the relative movement, which is a normal phenomenon. Note: If you hear fabric or leather tearing sound when the machine is running, please stop using it immediately and seek professional maintenance.

Fault	The massage wheel did not reach the shoulders or neck.
Solution	If the head does not touch the head cushion or the back does not touch the backrest, the shoulder position may be lower than the actual position during the body shape detection process. Sit in the deepest position of the seat, rest your head on the headrest, and start over from the beginning.

Fault	The unit is damaged. The power cord or power plug is abnormally hot.
Solution	To prevent accidents, be sure to contact an authorized service center.
