Fritillaria imperialis are most impressive eye-catching spring flowering bulbs, grow for their pendent, mainly bell-shaped flowers on leafy stems. They grown strong tall stalks, topped by large, hanging blooms and a fringe of slender leaves. It is commonly known as 'Crown Imperial'.

*Deer resistant, good cut flower, and multiplies well*

*Unique scent helps keep rodents out of your garden*

*Also known as Crown Imperial bulbs*

*About This Variety:* Flowers are large, downward facing, yellow in color, and held high, well above the foliage. Grows 36-40" tall with lance- shaped, glossy green leaves. Stunning specimen which is a must have for that curb-appeal.

*Growing Instructions:* Plant one bulb per square foot, immediately upon receipt

*Care Tip:* Plant bulb at a 45 degree angle so that the water doesn't sit in the stem hole of the bulb

*Exposure:* Likes partially shaded

*Height:* Grows 36" tall

*Spacing:* Plant 8" apart, 5-6" deep

*USDA Zones:* Hardy in USDA zones 5-8
