Press the snap lock and make sure both locks are fit perfectly into the holes of plastic connectors.

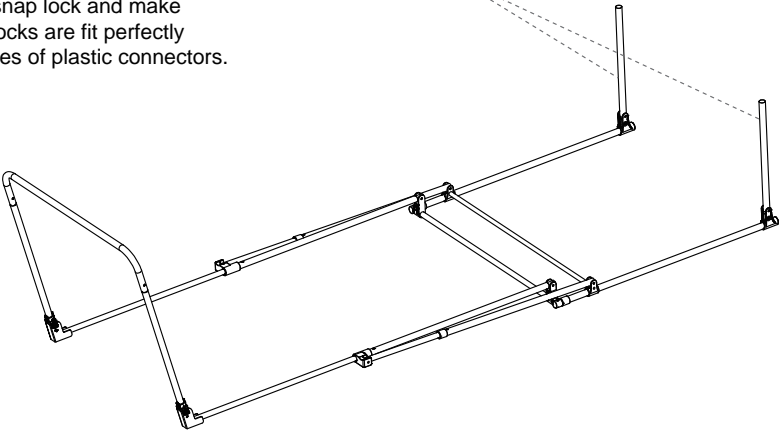

Please rope the velcro twice around the corner of bar. Make sure the stop net is tight.

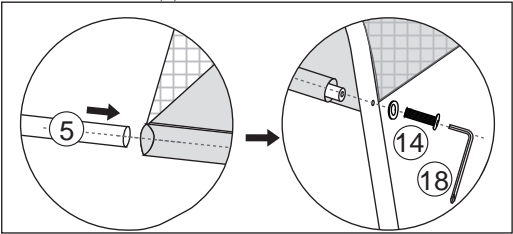
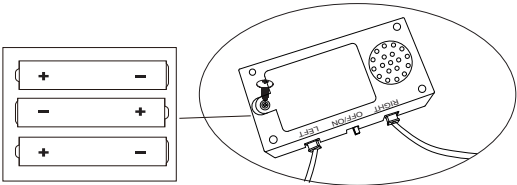


1. Both hand to pull up the cross bar.






1. Pull up the lock device. If you find the lock device is difficult to pull up, please pull the pole toward your position gently.



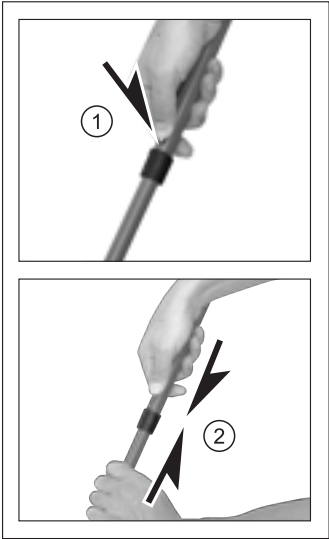
2. Turn the lock device clockwise

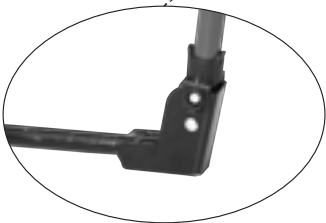


Turn the lock device anticlockwise to release the lock device.

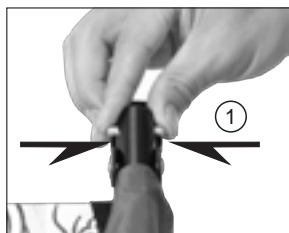
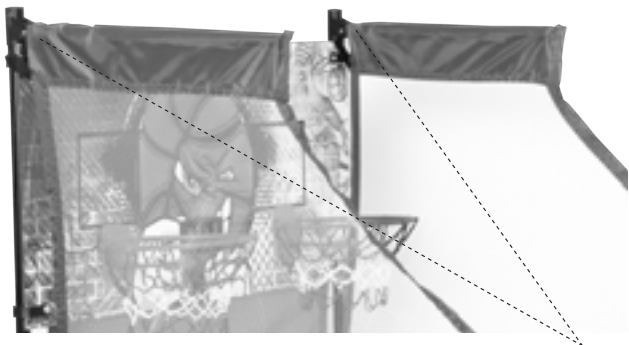
Pull up the frame until the lock devices are in lock position



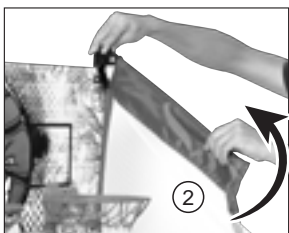
Make sure the lock devices stay securely in lock position

Notice: If the frame still can be moved all the way to the floor, it means the lock devices are not in the lock position. Please repeat the steps again.

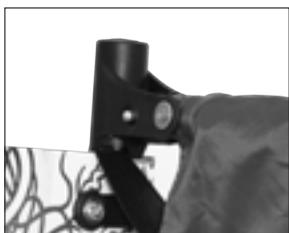
