Van Zyverden's WIND FLOWER/ANEMONE BLUE SHADES





Anemones are lovely small bulbs and are often underestimated like a little treasure. They are an excellent ground cover and a good choice for woodland and rock gardens. The foliage is low-clumping, but the blooms are very colorful.

About This Variety: Blue shades delivers that sought after blue hue in the garden.

Growing Instructions: Inexpensive and easy to grow, they are the perfect companion for late daffodils and later blooming tulips. For best effect, plant in mass sweeps with a lavish hand, planting about 16 per square foot. Purchase several packs to produce that colorful curb appeal effect.


Care Tip: Soak the corms in lukewarm water overnight before planting to jump start development. Plant after danger of frost.
