CHOKING HAZARD — This item contains small parts that can be swallowed. Keep children and pets away during assembly.

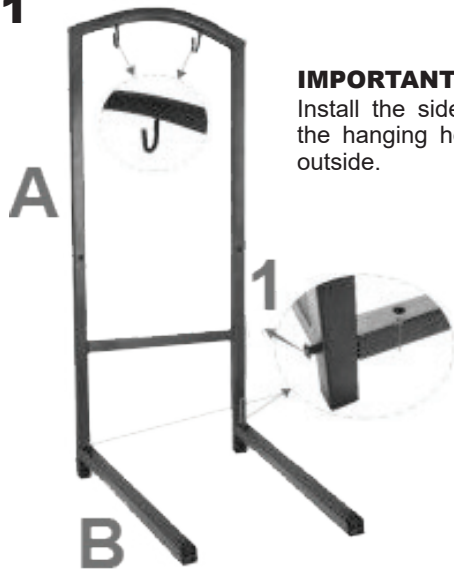
ASSEMBLY

Review all steps and understand assembly before beginning.

Do not fully tighten hardware until all components have been loosely assembled.

STEP 1

A: 1
B: 2

IMPORTANT:

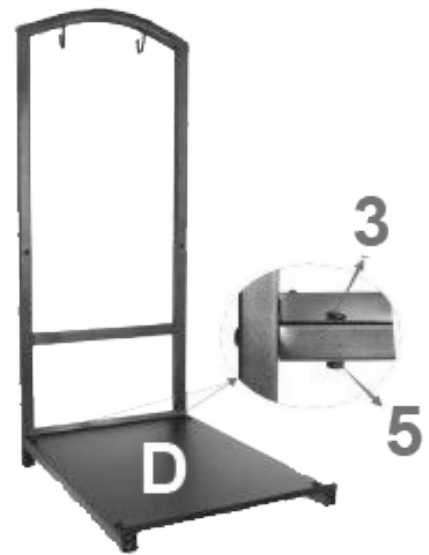
Install the side panel with the hanging hooks on the outside.

- Remove one M6x40mm Bolt (1) from the one end of each Bottom Bar (B).
- Align Bottom Bar (B) with bottom of Side Panel (A). Loosely secure by hand-tighten M6x40mm Bolt (1).
- Repeat to loosely fasten the remaining bottom bar to the opposite side.

Do not fully tighten any bolts until after Step 4 is complete.

STEP 2

D: 1
3: 4
5: 4



- Remove M5x30mm Bolts (1) and M5 Nut (3) from the bottom bars.
- With the ledge facing upward and flush with the side panel, secure Bottom Panel (D) to the bottom bars using four M5x30mm Bolts (3) and four M5 Nuts (5).

Do not fully tighten any bolts until after Step 4 is complete.

STEP 3

C: 1
2: 2
4: 2



- Fasten Grille Panel (C) to the side panel by hand-tightening two M6x30mm Bolts (2) and two M6 Nuts (4).

Do not fully tighten any bolts until after Step 4 is complete.

STEP 4

A: 1

IMPORTANT:

Install the side panel with the hanging hooks on the outside.

- Repeat steps 1 and 3 to connect remaining Side Panel (A).

Tighten all bolts after this step is complete.

Care & Maintenance

SAFE USE: Only use on a flat, level surface. Do not stand or sit on the log rack.

- Supervise children at all times; do not allow children to play on or play with any part of this product.
- Firmly secure all hardware before use.
- Inspect hardware often and tighten as necessary.
- Do not use the brush to sweep live coals (embers).
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials to clean this unit.
- This product is for residential use only.
