Step 1: Getting Started

Installing your new one or two car garage door cover is easy, but best accomplished by two people. Each cover is designed for a snug fit, so be prepared to stretch, and pull your cover into position.

Be careful, a garage door's frame, track, and hardware can be sharp! With your garage door closed, take a rag or paper towel, and clean the excess grease buildup from your garage door's track and nullev.

Step 2: Positioning

Open your garage door and lay the cover on the top (exterior surface) of the door. It's important to slide the cover through the curved garage door arm as you work the cover over the door.

Then, carefully side the cover across the entire width of the door making sure the decorative image facing up. Note: You don't need to fully spread out the cover across the entire surface yet; just position the top corners of the cover near the top corners of your garage door.



Step 3: Top Collar Attachment

Your cover is equipped with four reinforced collars at each corner. Carefully wrap the top collars of the cover around the top corners of the garage door.


Attach zipper **side A** and zipper **side B** between the side of the garage door and track. Do the same on the opposite top corner. Be prepared to stretch the cover when attaching the final top zipper.


BE CARFUL, DO NOT WRAP THE COVER AROUND THE TRACK!
The collar should only be wrapping around the garage door panel.



With the top collars installed, the easiest way to layout your cover is to close your garage and allow the cover to fall and hang loosely. As you close your garage door, double check for any snags or binding issues.

With someone helping you, reopen the garage door while lightly pulling down on the bottom edge to ensure the cover is not pinched by the closing seems between each door panel. This will smooth out your cover and allow you to more easily attach the bottom collars.





Step 5: Bottom Collar Attachment

With the garage open, carefully wrap the bottom collars of the cover around the bottom corners of the garage door. Attach zipper side C and zipper side D between the side of the garage door and track
