

*Van Zyverden's*  
**GLORIOSA ROTHSCILDIANA**



Originating in the tropics of South Africa and India, Gloriosa Lilies bear a name that means "full of glory," which is appropriate for such a showy, exotic, tropical trailing vine that produces flame colored blooms. It is deer resistant, attracts butterflies, and is a good choice for containers for use on the balcony or indoors.

*Climbs like a vine,  
5 to 6 feet tall*

*Showy, bright red flower  
edged with yellow*

*Can also be grown  
in containers, on a patio  
or indoors as a houseplant*

*About This Variety:* The vines are lightweight and are fine with slender supports.

*Growing Instructions:* Plant tubers horizontally after last frost date.

*Care Tip:* For earlier bloom, tubers may be started indoors in late winter and moved outside after last frost date.

*Exposure:* Full sun to part shade

*Height:* Grows 5-6' tall

*Spacing:* Plant- 8-12" apart, 2-4" deep

*Hardy in:* USDA zones 8-10
