Van Zyverden's GLORIOSA ROTHSCHILDIANA





Originating in the tropics of South Africa and India, Gloriosa Lilies bear a name that means "full of glory," which is appropriate for such a showy, exotic, tropical trailing vine that produces flame colored blooms. It is deer resistant, attracts butterflies, and is a good choice for containers for use on the balcony or indoors.

Climbs like a vine, 5 to 6 feet tall Showy, bright red flower edged with yellow

Can also be grown in containers, on a patio or indoors as a houseplant About This Variety: The vines are lightweight and are fine with slender supports.

Growing Instructions: Plant tubers horizontally after last frost date.

Care Tip: For earlier bloom, tubers may be started indoors in late winter and moved outside after last frost date.

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Height: Grows 5-6' tall

Spacing: Plant- 8-12" apart, 2-4" deep

Hardy in: USDA zones 8-10
