SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

This manual contains important safety and operating instructions. Read all instructions and follow them with use of this product.

Step 1

Attach the four casters to the bottom tray (#6) with 16pcs M6 x 16 bolts (#8). Mount both swivel casters (with brake) (#2) on the same side, and mount both fixed casters (#1) on the opposite side. Wrench tighten.

Step 2

Attach the columns (#7) in either direction to the bottom tray (#6) with 8pcs M6 x 14 screws (#8), 8pcs M6 washers with spring (#10), 8pcs M6 washers (#9) and 8pcs M6 nuts (#11).



Step 3

Attach the middle tray (#5) to the four columns (#7) with 8pcs M6 x 14 screws (#8), 8pcs M6 washers with spring (#10), 8pcs M6 washers (#9), and 8pcs M6 nuts (#11). Repeat the above step to attach the top tray. Please do not attach screws in the two holes noted in the diagram below, these two holes will be used to attach the handle in a later step.

Step 4

Attach the handle (#3) and two handle brackets (#4) to the top tray with 2pcs M6 x 14 screws (#8), 2pcs M6 washers with spring (#10), 2pcs M6 washers (#9) and 2pcs M6 nuts (#11).

Please install the handle on the same side as the swivel casters (with brake) (#2).
