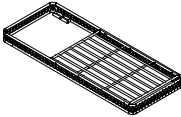
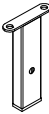
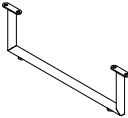
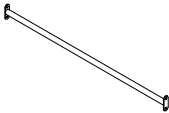
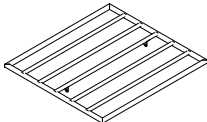
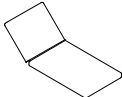
Never adjust Chaise Lounge or recliner backrest while seated.
Always make sure the backrest is flat before moving Chaise Lounge.
Serious finger, hand, or other bodily injuries may result from adjusting the Chaise Lounge backrest position while seated.

Care & Maintenance

- ❌  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ❌  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ❌  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ❌  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ❌  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and/or place under patio or awnings.
- e  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

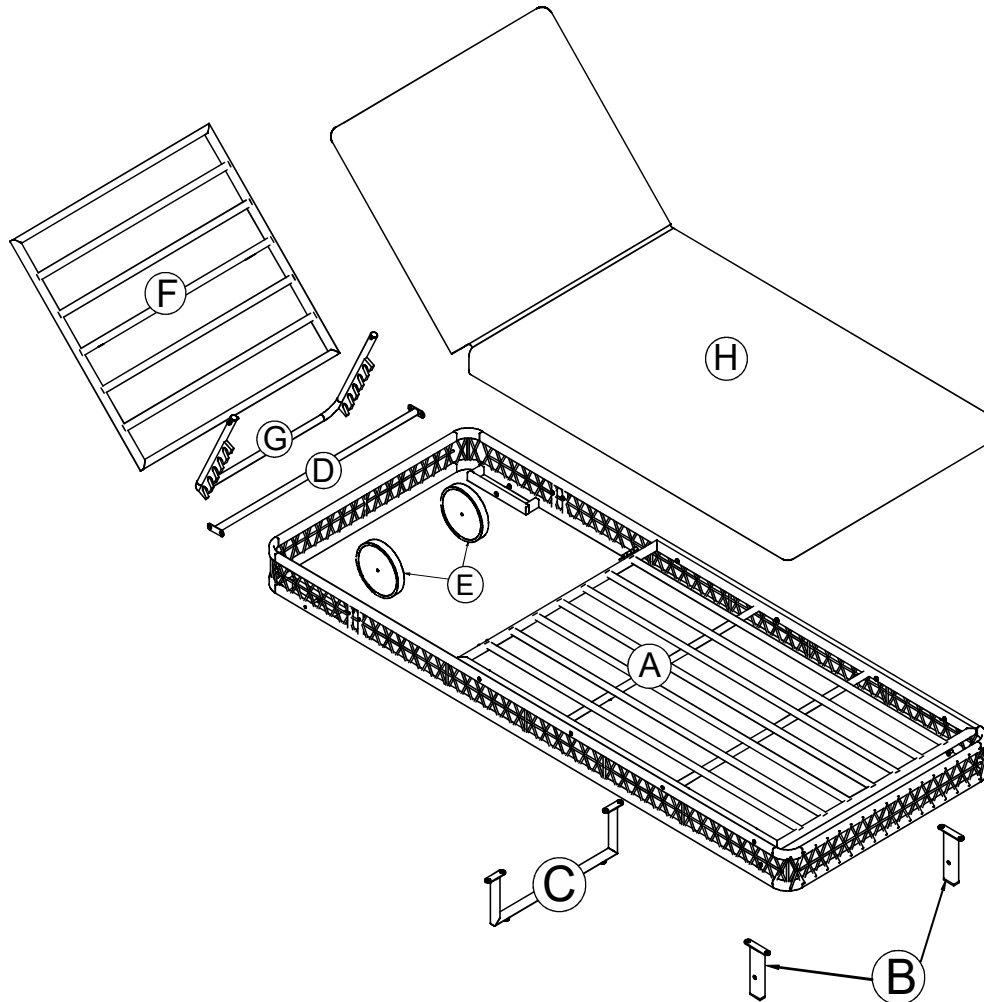

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



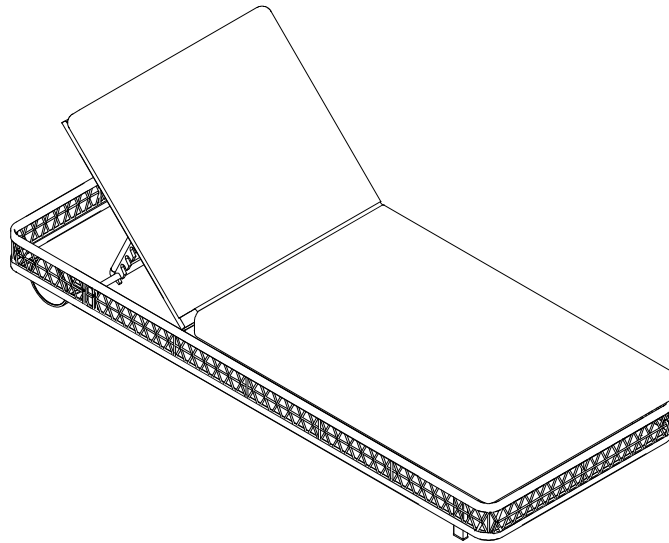
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

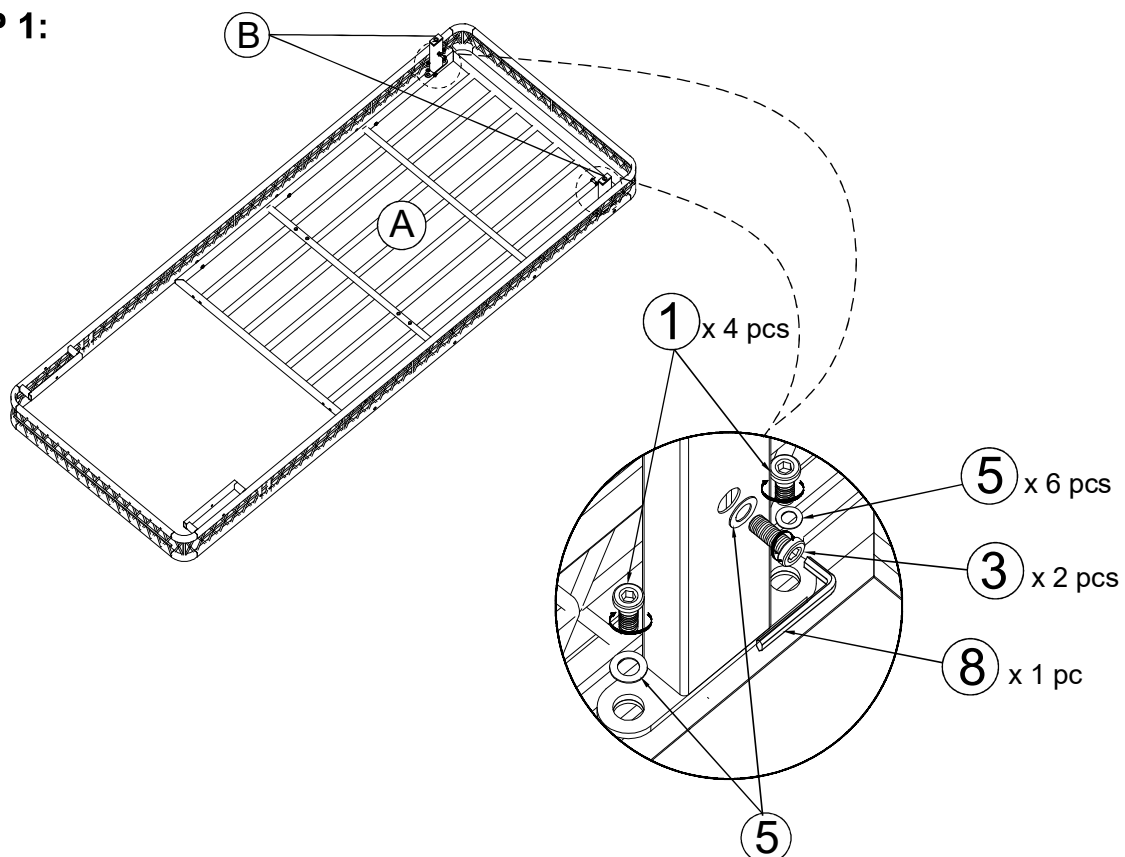
Assembly Steps

Overview



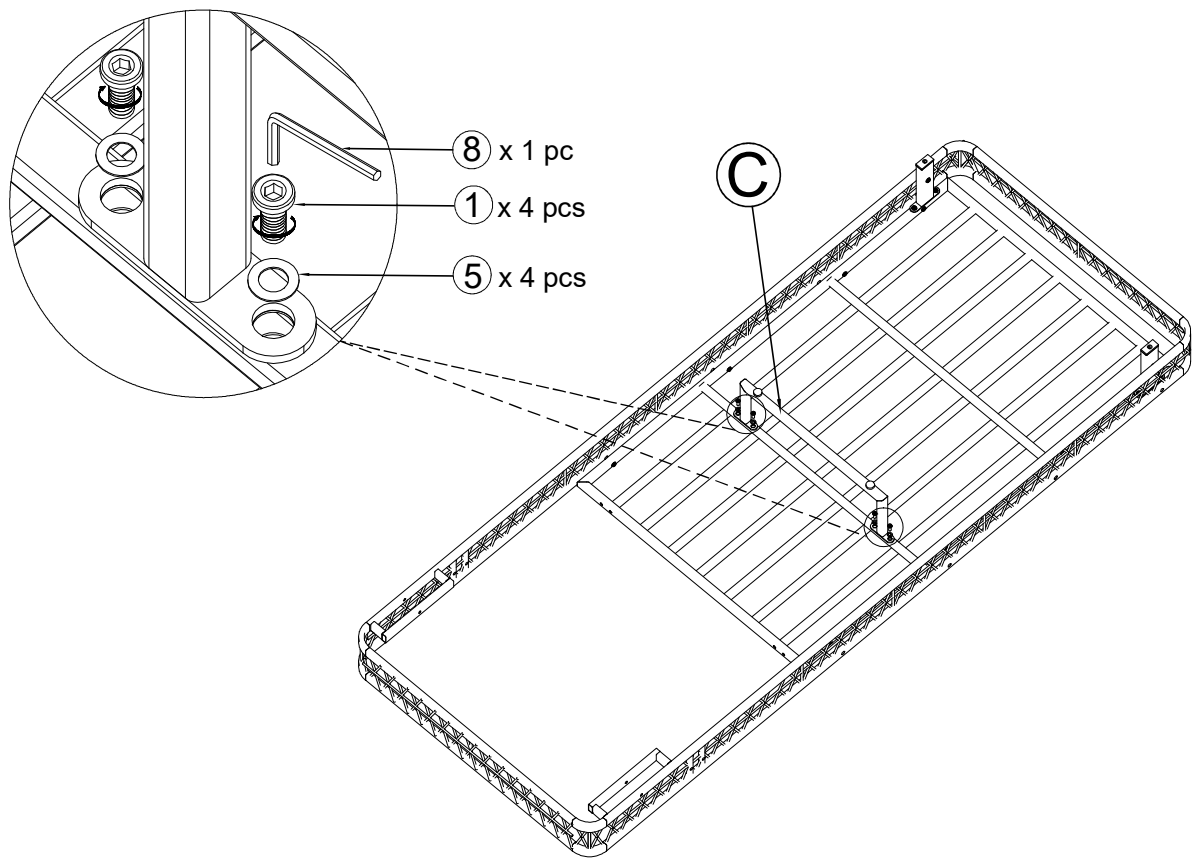
This Chaise Lounge has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chaise Lounge parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

STEP 1:



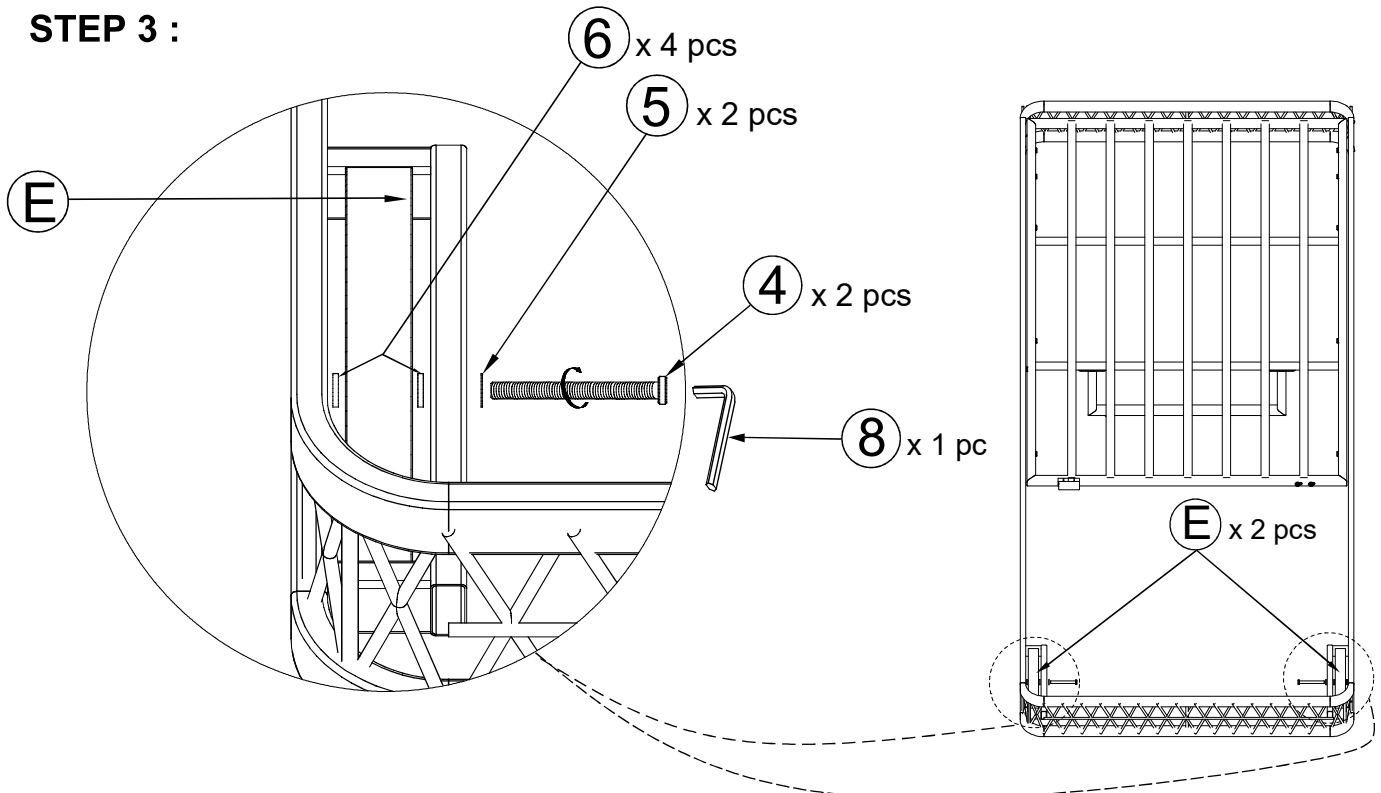
With the assistance of another adult, place the **Bed Frame (A)** face up, then attach the **Bed Legs (B)** to the **Bed Frame (A)** using **BOLTS (1)**, **(3)**, and **FLAT WASHERS (5)**, securing with the **ALLEN WRENCH (8)** as shown in the illustration above.

STEP 2 :



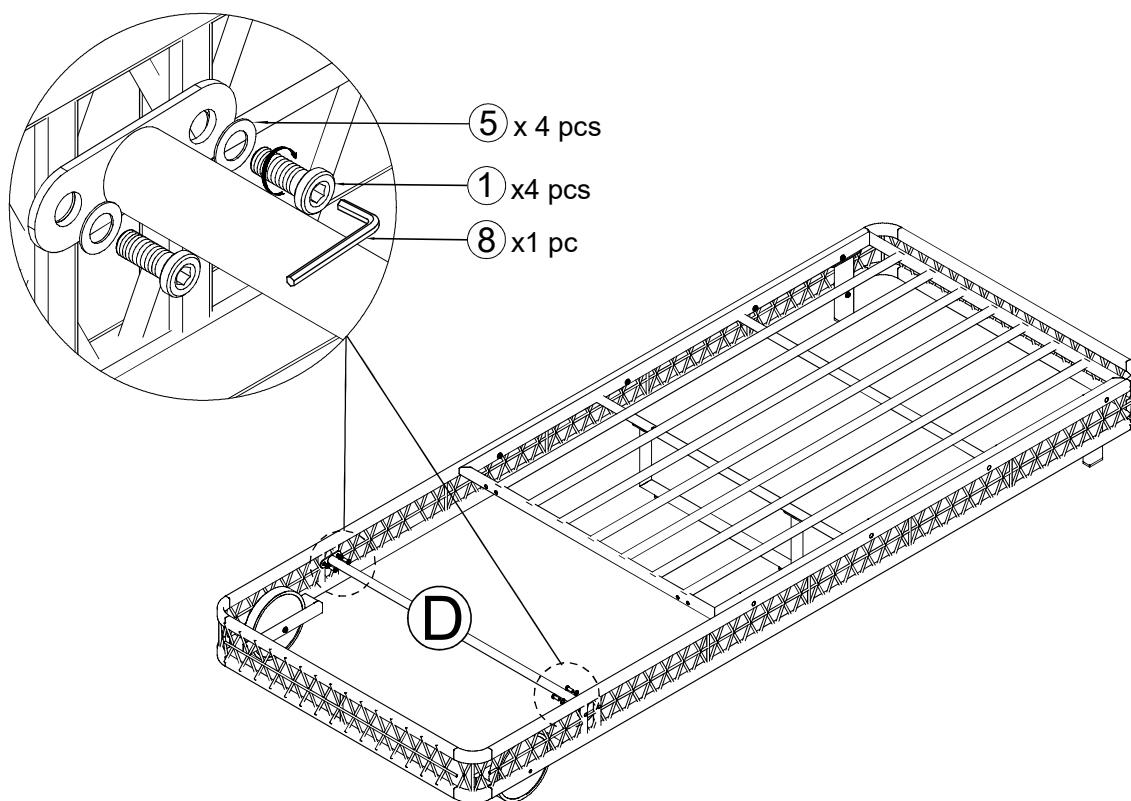
Attach the **Bed Legs (C)** to the **Bed Frame (A)** using **BOLTS (1)** and **FLAT WASHERS (5)**, securing with the **ALLEN WRENCH (8)** as shown in the illustration above.

STEP 3 :



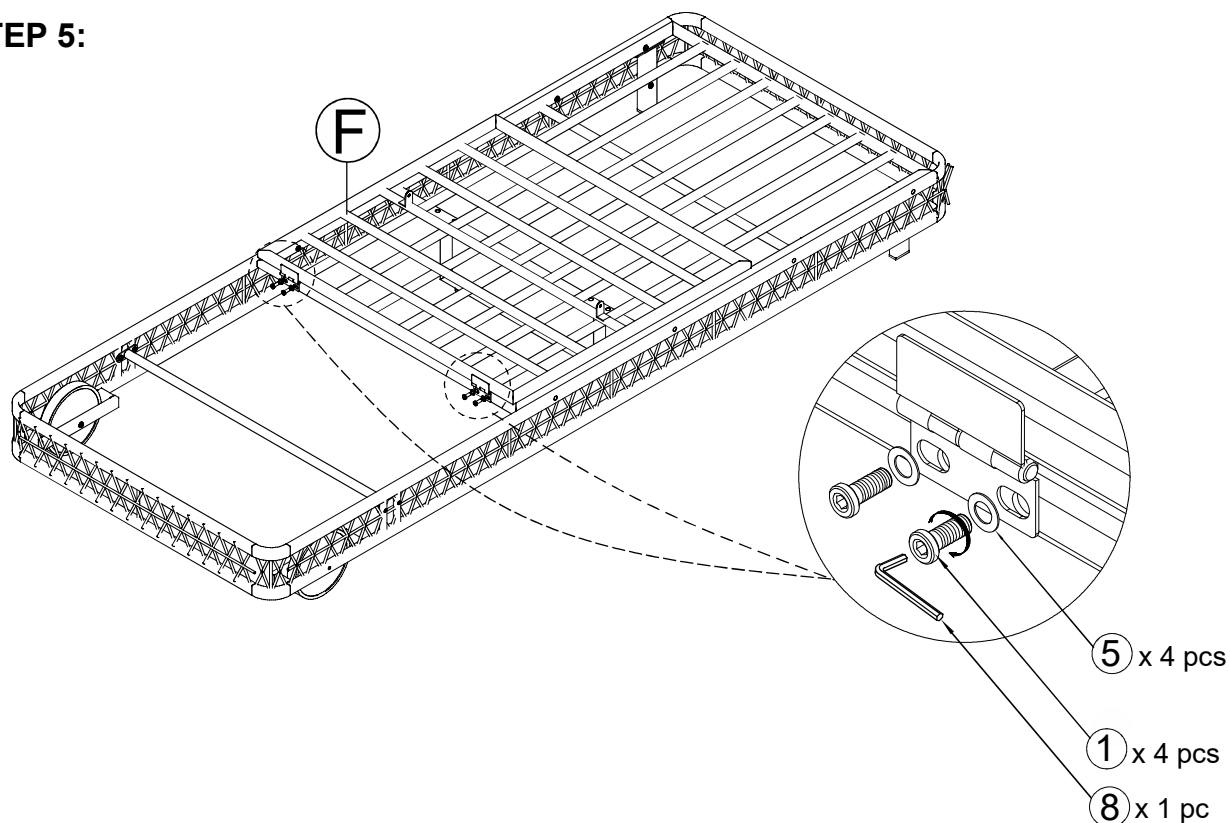
With the assistance of another adult, place the **Bed Frame (A)** face up, then attach the **Wheel (E)** to the **Bed Frame (A)** using the **BOLT (4)**, **FLAT WASHER (5)**, and **PLASTIC FLAT WASHER (6)** secured with the **ALLEN WRENCH (8)** as shown in the illustration above.

STEP 4:



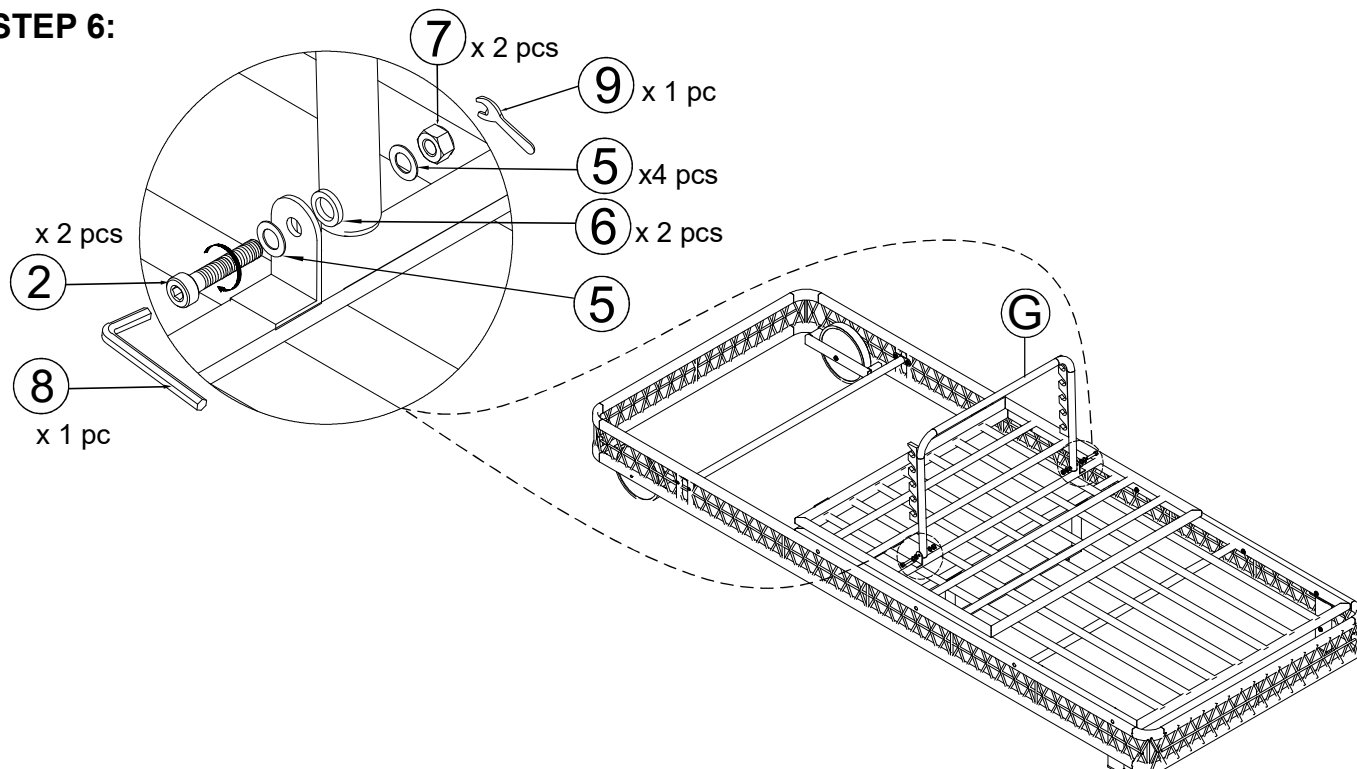
With the assistance of another adult, place the **Bed Frame (A)** face down, then attach the **Connecting Bar (D)** to the **Bed Frame (A)** using **BOLTS (1)** and **FLAT WASHERS (5)**, securing with the **ALLEN WRENCH (8)** as shown in the illustration above.

STEP 5:



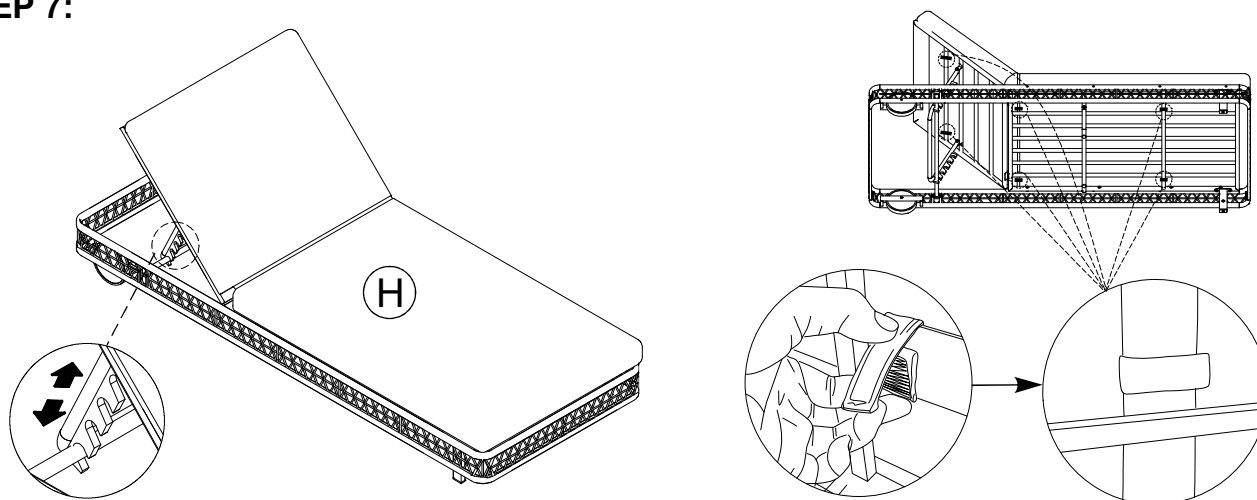
Attach the **Backrest (F)** to the **Bed Frame (A)** using **BOLTS (1)** and **FLAT WASHERS (5)**, securing with the **ALLEN WRENCH (8)** as shown in the illustration above.

STEP 6:



With the assistance of another adult, place the **Bed Frame (A)** face down, then attach the **Position frame of backrest (G)** to the **Backrest (F)** using **BOLTS (2)**, **FLAT WASHERS (5)**, **PLASTIC FLAT WASHER (6)**, and **Nuts (7)** securing with the **ALLEN WRENCH (8)** and a **Wrench (9)** as shown in the illustration above.

STEP 7:



Functional : 4- Level Adjustable Backrest

With assistance from your adult partner, stand the Chaise Lounge up. Apply pressure downward onto the Chaise Lounge with both your hands. This pressure will help the Legs and Chaise Lounge reach full alignment. Check for wobbles on a level surface.

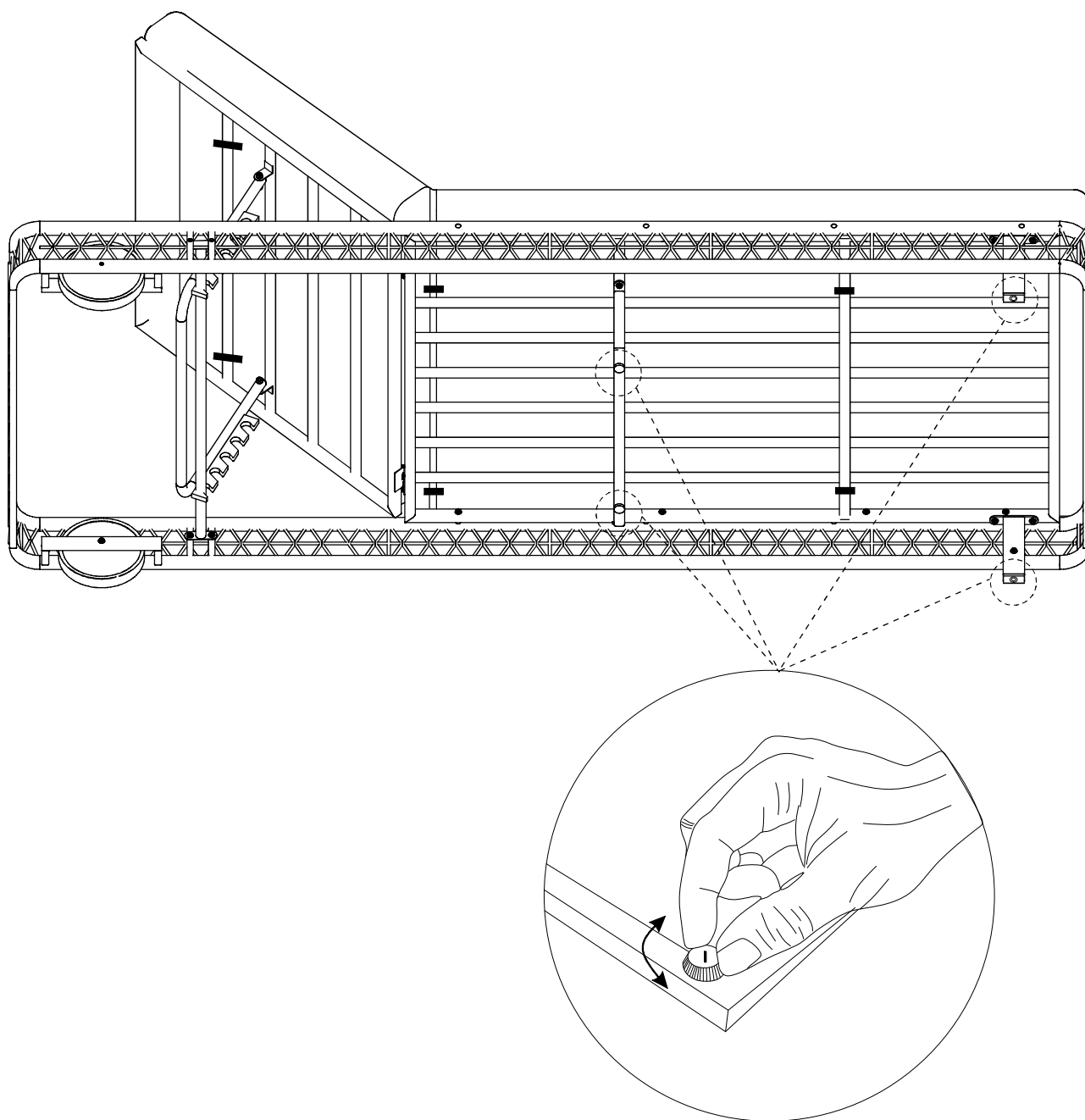
If no wobbles are found, proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner until they are evenly secured.

When tightening the Bolts, tighten sequentially.

Do not fully tighten any Bolt before moving on to the next one.

If there are still wobbles after tightening, loosen the Bolts and repeat the above process. Your Chaise Lounge is ready to use.

This Chaise Lounge can only be used on a flat, level surface.



"For uneven surfaces, adjust the height at these positions to balance the Chaise Lounge."

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
