Care & Maintenance

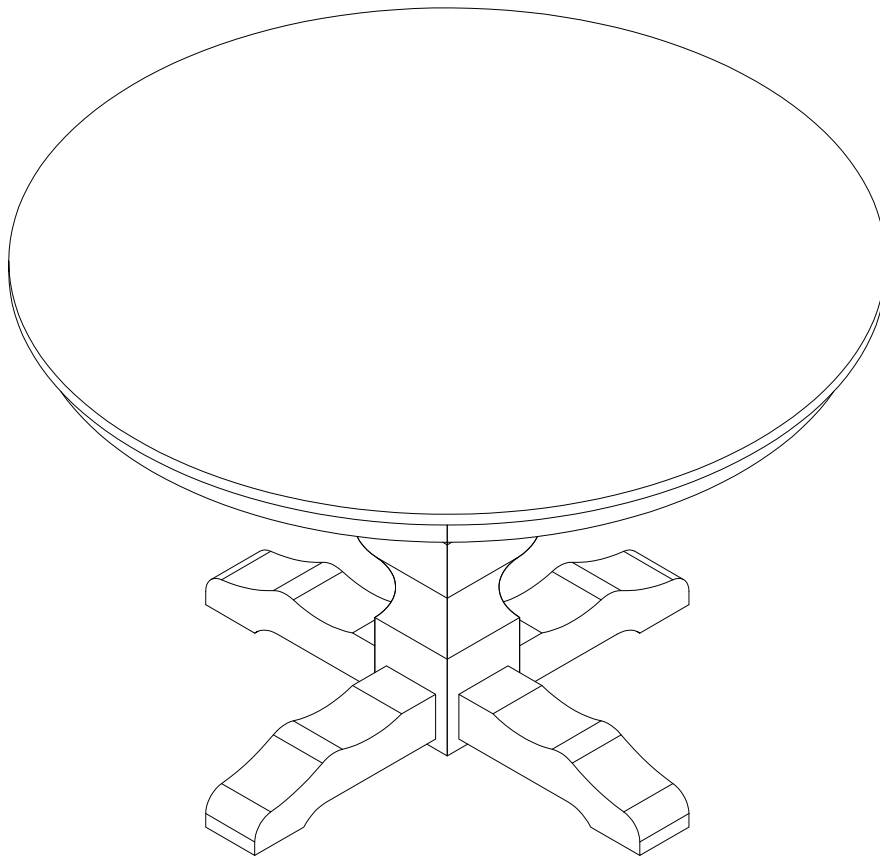
	●Not for commercial use. For residential use only.

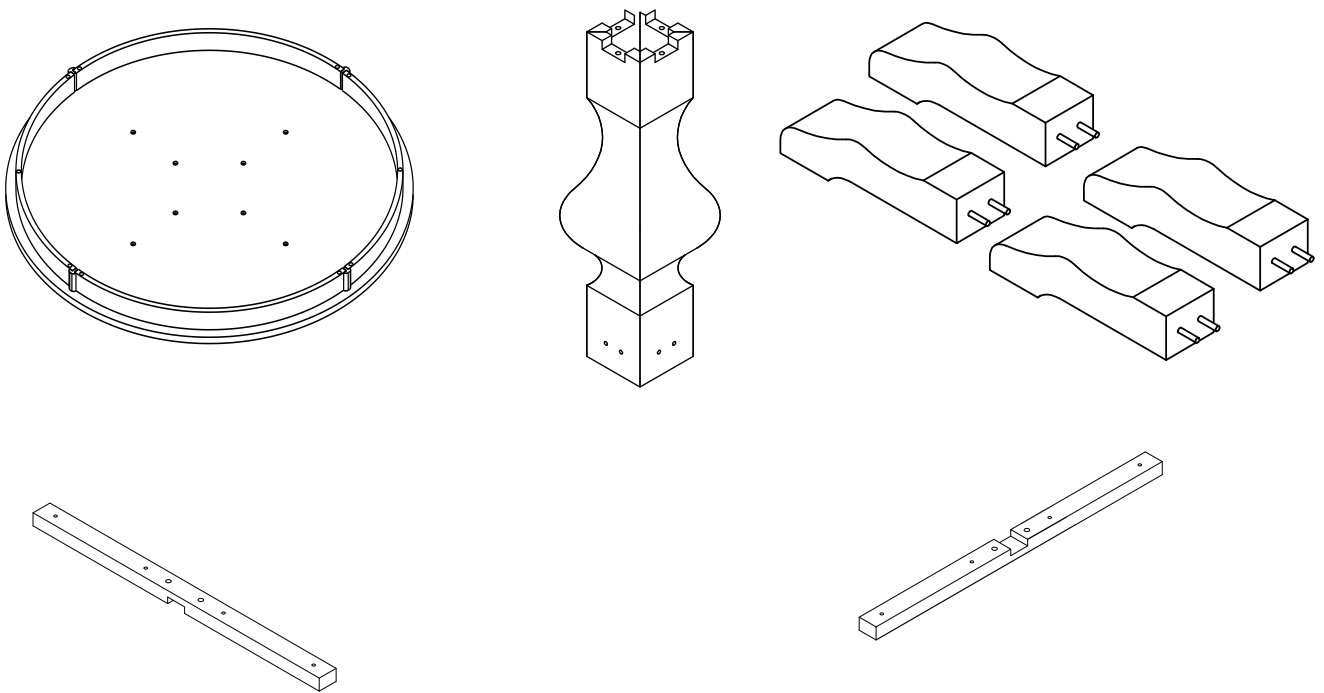
Overview



FRONT FACING

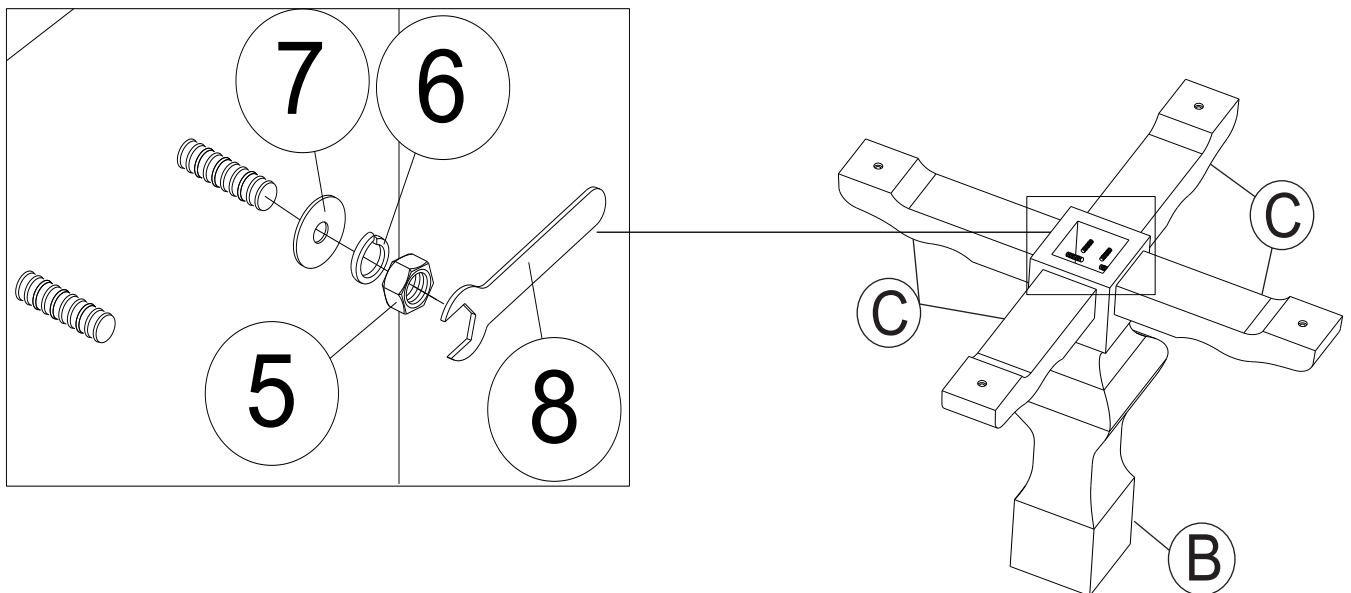
This Dining Table has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Dining Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

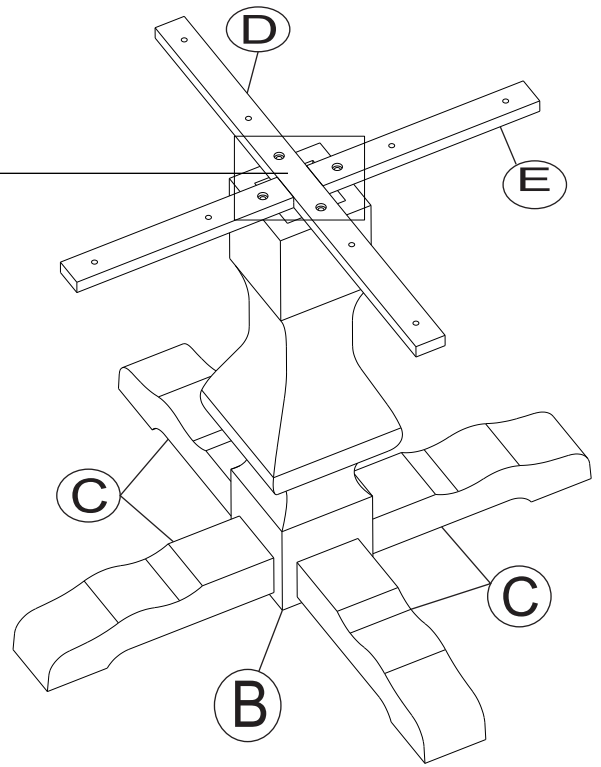
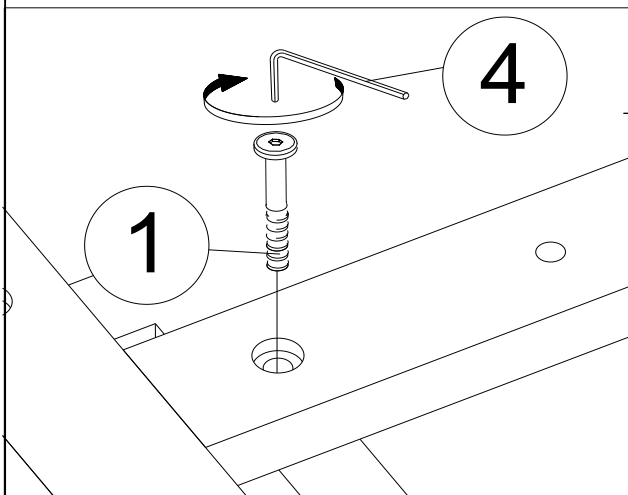
Step 2



Place the Pedestal (B) and the Base Leg (C) on on a clean, non-marring surface. Attach the Base Leg (C) to the Pedestal (B) by inserting the Hex Nuts (⑤), Spring Washers (⑥) and Flat Washers (⑦). Tighten with the Spanner (⑧) as shown in the picture.

Fully tighten the Bolts.

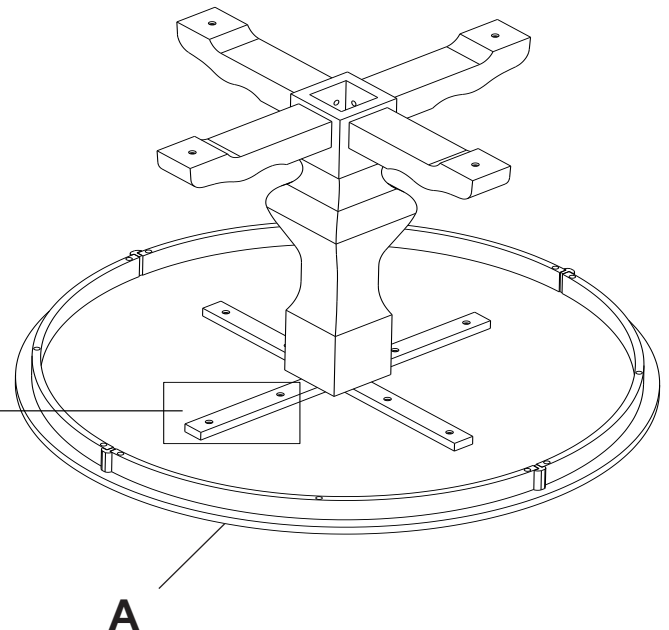
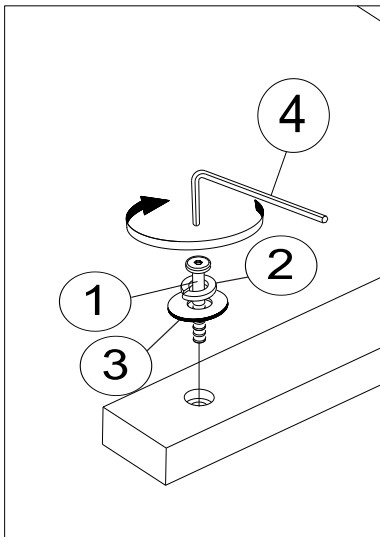
Step 3



Attach the Upper Support (D) and Lower Support (E) to the Pedestal (B).
Using the Bolt (①) to tighten 100% by Allen Key (④)

Fully tighten the Bolts.

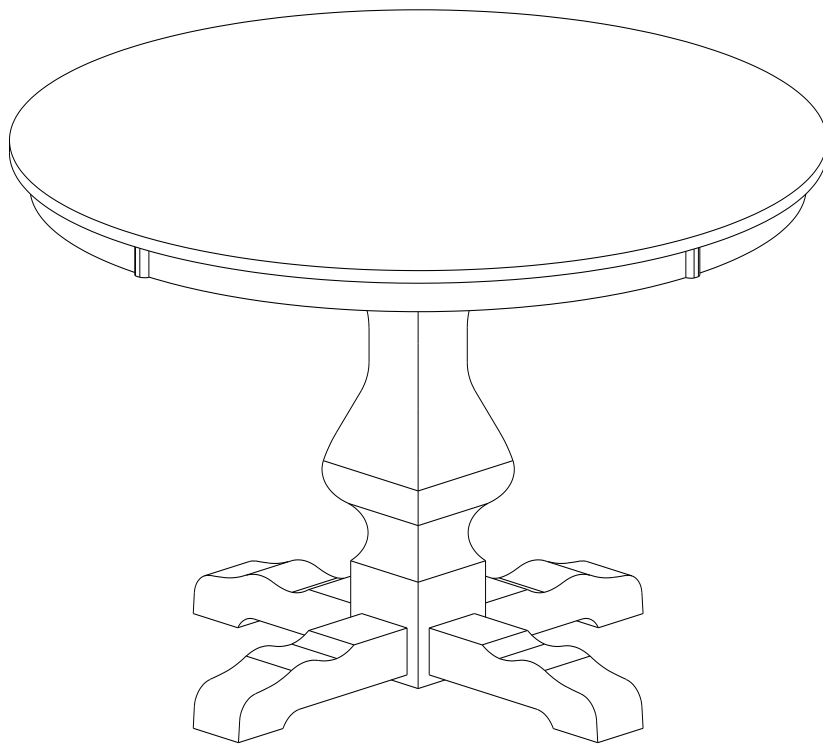
Step 4



After that, stand the frame assembled in step 3 turn of side down and set it on underside of the Table Top. as shown in the picture. Then make sure the hole of the Cross Support (D & E) align with hole of the Table Top (A) by inserting the Bolts(①) Spring Washers (②) and Flat Washers (③).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Repeat the same process to install the remaining positions.



Turn the Table upright carefully with assistance from your adult partners
Exert pressure floorwards, onto the Table with both your hands.
This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status.
Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.
If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner,
until evenly secured.

When tightening the Bolts tighten sequentially.

**Do not tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one.
If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts and excute the same above
process.**

If the Table is not Stable it could lead to damage to the product.

Inspect Table and make sure all parts are adequately connected.
Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
