

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

Pull out the source wires from the outlet box.

Make wire connections using wire nuts as follows:

—Connect the hot wire (usually black insulation) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.

—Connect the neutral wire (usually white insulation) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.

—Attach the fixture grounding wire (usually green insulation or bare wire) to the mounting plate with the green grounding screw, and then connect it to the house grounding wire with the wire nut.

Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.

1. Thread the fixture mounting screws through mounting plate, and then secure them with two lock nuts. Adjust the length of fixture mounting screws if necessary.
2. Attach mounting plate to the outlet box using two mounting screws.
3. Thread the fixture wire through the tube and the canopy.
4. Attach one end of the tube to the canopy, and the other end to the threaded pipe of the fixture.
5. Attach the long threaded pipe to coupling.
