

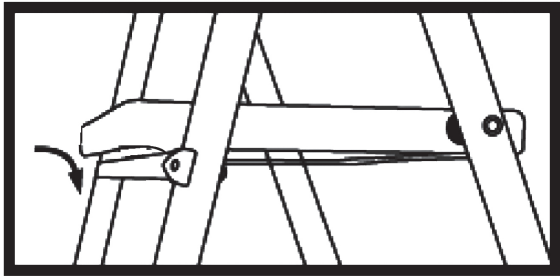
USING THE LADDER:

- 1.Do not overreach, Users should keep their body in the centre of the width ofthe ladder, keeping both on the same step whilst working.
 - 2.Ladders should only be used for light work of short duration.
 - 3.Face the ladder when ascending and descending.
 - 4.Keep a secure grip on the ladder when ascending and descending.
 - 5.Wear slip resistant shoes.
 - 6.Equipment carried while using a ladder should be light and easy to handle.
- Do not try to move the ladder whilst in use.

NOTE: Repairs and maintenance to be done by competent person only, Store in a cool dry place.

OPENING THE LADDER:

Caution: always check that the ladder is 'LOCKED' before you climb the ladder.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:
BEFORE USE:

- 1.When transporting ladders on roof bars or in a truck, ensure they are suitably placed to prevent damage and are securely tied down.
- 2.Inspect the ladder after purchase and before first use to confirm condition and operation of all parts.
- 3.Visually check the ladder is not damaged and is safe to use at the start of each use.
- 4.For domestic use only.
- 5.Ensure the ladder is suitable for the task.
- 6.Do not use a damaged ladder, check every step prior to each use.
- 7.Remove any contamination from the ladder such as wet paint, mud, old or snow.
- 8.Always wear sturdy boots with good grip, never wear smooth- soled footwear when using theladder.

INSERT THE TOP RAIL INTO THE SIDES
Then use the Screws A provided to attach the side rails to the top rail and the ladder.



INSTALL THE TRAY TO TOP RAIL
1.Install the tray to top rail with Screws B.
2.Install the tray to steel bars with Screws C.
