## Van Zyverden's FORSYTHIA LYNWOOD GOLD





Lynwood Gold Forsythia is an ornamental deciduous shrub known for its very heavy blooming nature. Flowers cover its bare branches with their yellow brilliance and will bloom for weeks. It is a multi-branched and upright shrub that has a somewhat spreading nature. They look great scattered through the garden, or used as a hedge. NOTE: What we ship is two year old ROOT STOCK, ranging 12-18 inches in height and is not a fully grown foliated potted plant.

About This Variety: After the flowers fade away, it will produce 3 inch ovate leaves that are a splendid, deep green with delicate toothed margins, which will turn yellow with a hint of purple in the fall for stunning fall color.

Growing Instructions: Dig a hole about a foot deep and a foot wide. Set the plant in the hole, and fill it half full with soil. Water. After water is drained, fill the rest of the hole with the remaining soil. Then water thoroughly again and continue doing so regularly. Fertilization may be necessary.


Care Tip: It can be pruned back to any size as it will grow quickly in height and width, or you can just sit back and let it grow as its carefree and watch as the spring in your yard is heralded by the outpouring of golden blooms. If you decide to prune, do so immediately after spring flowering.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 6-9' tall

Spacing: Plant- 6-9' apart, crown at soil level

Hardy in: USDA zones 5-8
