MOUNTING THE FIXTURE (Fig.1)

- 1. Shut off power at the fuse box or circuit breaker and remove the old fixture including the mounting hardware.
- 2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clean area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
- Thread screws (B) into pre-drilled holes on circular strap (G) spaced same distance apart as holes in canopy (I) and tighten with nuts (E). The length of screws (B) may be adjusted if necessary.
- Attach circular strap (G) to junction box (not included) using mounting screws (D). The side of circular strap marked "GND" must face out.

CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig.2)

- 5. Connect the electrical wires as shown in Fig.2, making sure that all wire connectors (C) are secured. If your junction box has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect the fixture's ground wire directly to the circular strap (G) using the green screw provided.
- 6. Tuck wire connectors neatly into the junction box.

FINISHING THE INSTALLATION (Fig.1)

- 7. Place canopy (I) over screws (B) and secure with finials (A).
- Unscrew metal ring (F) and place glass shade (H) over socket cup. Secure glass shade (H) with metal ring (F).
- Install three medium base (E26) bulbs up to 60 watts each or CFL or LED equivalent (not included) in accordance with the fixture specification—DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING! (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!).



Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture.
