INSTALLATION STEPS

• Flip the countertop over.



Outline The Rim

- Positioned centrally over the sink cutout, ensuring equal overhang or reveal on all sides of the sink.
- Outline the outer rim of the sink on the bottom side of the countertop with a pencil or fine-tipped marker.
- If the cutout is not suitable for the sink, use a jigsaw to cut.

NOTE: Please wear protective equipment when using jigsaw.



Place Sink Clips

- Place your anchoring posts of the undermount sink clips (Not included). Use epoxy to stick them to the countertop.
- Apply silicon within the traced sink rim area or the underside of the countertop.



Alternative Solution 1:

- If moving the countertop is impossible, this solution is recommended:
- Prepare two pieces of 2x4 inch plywood, a screw rod, washers, and nuts, ensuring that one plywood piece is longer than the sink's cutout. (You can replace the screw rod, washers, and bolts to a bar clamp if possible.)



- Apply silicone to the rim of the sink and attach it to the underside of the countertop.
- Secure the sink in place using the plywood and the screw rod. Wait for the silicon to set.
- At the same time, attach the undermount sink clips beneath the countertop.

Alternative Solution 2:

- If you don't have any materials to secure the sink, you can try the following method:
- Stick the anchoring posts of the undermount sink clips to the underside of the countertop and install the clips loosely.
- Apply silicone to the rim of the sink and place it to the underside of the countertop.
- Keep the sink steady and turn each clip over its edge. Gradually tighten the clips to fasten the sink securely.

Final Placement

• Attach the undermount sink clips. Wait about one hour for the caulk to set.



TIP: If undermount sink clips are not on hand, galvanized hanging straps can also be a great alternative for mounting the sink.



• Move the countertop for the final placement.



PRODUCT CLEANING & CARE

- Routine Clean-Up: Make it a habit to clean your sink with gentle dish soap or detergent and lukewarm water. A soft cloth is all you need for wiping, followed by a thorough rinse. Drying off the sink afterwards keeps those pesky water spots at bay.
- Be Gentle on the Surface: Stay clear of rough cleaning agents, scouring pads, and steel wool, as they're no friends to your sink's finish. Stick to softer, kinder cleaning methods to keep it looking its best.
- **Tackling Tough Stains:** For stubborn stains, a simple half-and-half solution of water with either bleach or vinegar, or a gentle cleaner, should do the trick.
- Keeping Buildup at Bay: Avoid letting water sit in your sink to prevent mineral deposits from forming. A soft solution of vinegar and water can help clean up any buildup that does occur.
- Installation and Upkeep: Make sure your sink's installation is spot on, calling in the experts if you're unsure. Keep an eye out for any signs of wear and tear, and deal with them swiftly to keep your sink in tip-top shape.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

PROBLEM & RECOMMENDED ACTION

Detecting Water Leaks:

- Inspect underneath the sink for moisture or signs of leakage, focusing on the connections and joints.
- Wipe the faucet base, drain, and piping with a dry cloth or paper towel to check for dampness, indicating leaks.
- Quiet down the room and listen for any dripping sounds from the faucet or piping.
- Fill the sink and then drain it, watching the drain pipes for leaks as the water exits.
- Examine the faucet and sink seals for any signs of cracking, wear, or separation that could lead to leaks.

Dealing With Faucet Blockages

- Unscrew the tip of the faucet to inspect the strainer for any trapped debris.
- Look for mineral deposits in the faucet, especially in hard water regions or if the faucet hasn't been used for some time.
- Should basic troubleshooting fail to improve water flow, it may be time to get a plumber to check for more complex blockages in the plumbing.

Addressing Stains and Discoloration:

- Use gentle, non-abrasive cleaners for routine cleaning.
- Treat stubborn stains with baking soda or white vinegar, let it sit, then scrub softly with a dishcloth.

Dealing with Chips or Cracks:

- Contact us via email or phone for a replacement within the warranty period.
- Small damages can be fixed with a porcelain repair kit.
- For significant cracks or chips, professional repair is advisable.

Solving Fitting and Installation Challenges:

- If unfamiliar with remodeling, professional assistance is recommended.
- Confirm the sink's measurements and make necessary adjustments to the cabinet or countertop.
- Utilize shims to ensure the sink fits levelly and seal any gaps for a smooth adjustment.

Consumer Responsibilities For Undermount Sink Maintenance

- In hard water areas, prevent mineral deposits with regular rinsing and vinegar wipes.
- Clean your undermount sink weekly using non-abrasive cleaners to maintain its appearance and hygiene. Most non-abrasive cleaners are safe for your sink.
- Always follow specific instructions provided with the cleaning agents.
- Remove tough stains using a baking soda and vinegar paste. Use soft-bristled brushes for thorough cleaning, especially in corners and around the drain to avoid deposit accumulation.

WARNING

- DO NOT use cleaners containing any abrasive powders, bleach, ammonia, alcohol, or chlorine, because they can scratch and dull the sink's finish.
- AVOID using stiff brushes or steel wool for cleaning; opt for soft-bristled brushes to prevent surface damage.
- DO NOT neglect routine cleaning with suitable non-abrasive cleaners to preserve the sink's appearance and hygiene; always adhere to the cleaner's instructions.
- BEWARE of improper removal of tough stains; use only a baking soda and vinegar paste for safe and effective cleaning.
