 - So to the main fuse, or circuit breaker, box in your home. Place the main power switch in the "OFF" position.
 - » Place the wall switch in the "OFF" position.
- 4. Mounting surface should be clean, dry, flat, strong enough and 1/4" larger than the canopy on all sides. Any gaps between the mounting surface and canopy exceeding 3/16" should be corrected as required.
- 5. Make sure that the ceiling or wall can stand the weight of the lamp before installation.
- 6. Make sure the voltage you are using is 120V. The maximum wattage is LED, 25W.
- 7. Keep the lamp away from acidic and alkaline substances in case of damaging the surface of the lamp.
- 8. When replacing bulbs, you should turn off or unplug the lamp and you must wait until it is cool as bulbs get hot quickly.
- 9. The safety instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care must be used with any electrical products.

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Carefully remove the fixture from the carton and check that all parts and accessories are included as shown in the above illustration.
- 2. Turn off power

Before you start the installation, NEVER attempt any work without shutting off the electricity until the work is done.

- » Go to the main fuse, or circuit breaker, box in your home.
 - Place the main power switch in the "OFF" position.
- » Place the wall switch in the "OFF" position.
- 3. Make installation



Step A1 » 1) Unscrew canopy screws (F) from canopy (G).

2) Gently remove mounting plate (E) and then set them aside for later installation.

Step A2 » Carefully pass the supply wires from the outlet box through mounting plate (E).

- 1) NOTE:To drill the holes in the wall for anchors (A), attach mounting plate (E) to wall with screws (B & D)
- 2) Attach mounting plate (E) to outlet box and then mark the position of holes in the wall with a pen as shown in the illustration.
- 3) Drill holes and gently knock anchors (A) into the marked holes until anchors (A) are level with the wall.
- 4) Secure mounting plate (E) to the wall with screwing anchor screws (D) into anchors (A) and mounting screws (B) into holes of mounting plate (E).
- Step A3 » Make wire connections

Connect wires as below wires connecting shown. *PLEASE NOTE THAT GROUND WIRE IS BARE COPPER WIRE, NEVER CONNECT OTHER WIRES TO GROUND WIRES.*



Step A4 » 1) Position canopy (G) in place.

2) Carefully thread canopy screws (F) through the holes in canopy (G) and mounting plate (E) and then secure them by tightening canopy screws (F).

Step A5 » Please adjust the hanging height of the fixture :

- Press down and hold lock nuts (H) of canopy by hand.
- Pull or push cables (I) in and out of canopies to increase or decrease the hanging height.

4. Check everything is already installed properly, then you could turn on the light. Enjoy!

ORDERING PARTS

Keep this sheet for future reference in case you need to order replacement parts. All parts for this fixture can be ordered from the place of purchase. Be sure to use exact wording from illustration when ordering parts.

CLEANING

To clean, wipe the fixture with a soft cloth. Clean glass with a mild cleaner (such as mild and non-abrasive soap). Do not use abrasive materials such as scouring pads or powders, steel wool or abrasive paper.
