

Guide of Manual

- Instruction should be read carefully. But the manual may not cover every detail of all possible situations and steps. **Please contact us if further information and help are needed. We will respond in a timely manner.**
- **Please be patient that the other items are on the way if you buy more than one product.**

Warning

- It's kindly advised to assemble this product on a carpeted floor to protect it from being scratched.
- Small parts are included. Please keep the product away from children while assembling. Do not let children play or jump on the product. Do not stand on the item or use as a step ladder.
- Please pay attention to the sharp corners during assembly. We recommend the use of gloves to prevent the undesired injury.
- Prior to use, please check to see if there's any loosening screw or part. Make sure that each screw and part is correctly installed and securely fastened.
- It's unnecessary to use electric drill. Please at a low gear if you need.

Care and Maintenance

- It is recommended to use a rag to clean rattan furniture. Wipe it with a wet rag first, and then gently dry it with a soft rag.
- Avoid collision and scratches from hard objects with sharp tip, keep away from heat source, because high temperature will make the cane deformed.
- When using and storing, do not make it close or expose to the fire and heat source, do not put it in the sun for a long time.

Further Advice about the Furniture Care

- Fabric cushion covers are recommended to be hand-washed in cold and non-chlorine bleach instead of machine wash, in order to protect water-repellent coating. Cool iron and lay flat to dry.
- If it has not been used for more than two weeks, it is recommended to cover it with a protective cover or keep it in the room for storage.
- Following these important and helpful tips will help retain your furniture's performance even when it ages.
- Periodically (every 90 days) make sure the screws are fully tightened.






Max Weight Capacity

- "+" in below list indicates that additional pieces are replacement parts.






Exploded View





Locate the Armrests (A & B) to the Chair Back (D) by the pre-drilled holes. Fasten Bolts (M) with Washers (Q) by using Allen Key (R) to combine armrests and chair back together.


Locate the Chair Seat (C) to the Armrests (A & B) by the pre-drilled holes. Fasten Bolts (M) with Washers (Q) by using Allen Key (R) to combine armrests and chair seat together.






Locate the Chair Seat (C) to the Chair Back (D) by the pre-drilled holes. Fasten Bolts (M) with Washers (Q) by using Allen Key (R) to combine chair seat and chair back together.

Please completely tighten all bolts in Step 1, 2, and 3.







Fasten Bolts (N) into Washers (Q) & Screw Nuts (P) by using Allen Key (R) and Wrench (S) to combine Swivel turnplate (F) and Base (G) together. 4 bolts should be fastened totally. 8 Washers (Q) and 4 Screw Nuts (P) are needed for this step .


Make sure the label "UP" is facing up.


5 Locate the Swivel turnplate (F) to the Rocking Rack (E) by the pre-drilled holes. Fasten Bolts (N) with Washers (Q) into Screw Nuts (P) by using Allen Key (R) and Wrench (S). 4 bolts should be fastened totally. 8 Washers (Q) and 4 Screw Nuts (P) are needed for this step .



6 Please anchor the Swing arm (E) near the pre-drilled holes at the bottom of the Armrests (A) and (B). Place Flat washer (Q) and Nut (P) onto the Screw rod (M) in order, and use the Allen key (R) and the Open-end wrench (S), to secure the Screw rod (M). This will attach the swing arm to the main part of the sofa. Make sure to tighten all 4 screw rods.




Please ensure that part (E) is positioned as shown in the figure below: The two swing arms should be placed outside the black plastic part before installation.





Locate 4 Table Feet (I) to the Table Top (H) by the pre-drilled holes. Fasten Bolts (O) with Washers (Q) by using Allen Key (R) to combine table top and table feet together. 8 bolts should be fastened totally, 2 for each foot.

Locate Table Rack (J) to 4 Table Feet (I) by the pre-drilled holes. Fasten Bolts (O) with Washers (Q) by using Allen Key (R) to combine table rack and table feet together. 4 bolts should be fastened totally, 1 for each corner of the rack. Now fasten all bolts tight.
