Monarda, also known as Bee Balm, have fascinating scented masses of large flowers. It is a vigorous clump forming herbaceous perennial sure to return for years to come if planted zone appropriate. Thrives just about anywhere. The blossoms are difficult to describe but very decorative. The leaves are mint scented and are edible. Known to attract scores of butterflies and hummingbirds. Great for a wet garden!

*About This Variety:* White in the garden helps create a sense of peace, order, and efficiency and lends a cooling effect at the height of summer.

*Growing Instructions:* Not fussy at all and easy to grow provided plants are kept moist, and not allowed to dry out.

*Care Tip:* Deadhead spent flowers to encourage new blooms. Should be cut to the ground after flowering to promote new growth.

*Exposure:* Full sun to partial shade

*Height:* Grows 36-48" tall

*Spacing:* Plant 18" apart, 1.5-2" deep

*Hardy in:* USDA zones 4-10
