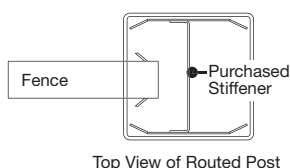

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

Vinyl gate posts require an internal support system for weight-bearing purposes therefore a post stiffener is required. Post stiffener needs to be purchased separately.

1.

Lay gate components on a smooth, flat and clean surface. Begin by arranging the rails in the correct orientations.

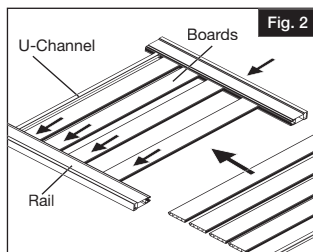
For gates with U-Channels, slide U-Channels onto end boards (Fig. 1).

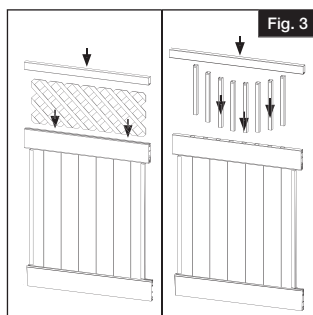
For Full Privacy Styles:

- a. Slide the boards into the bottom rail, starting and ending with end boards while locking each of them together (Fig. 2).
- b. Slide the top rail over the boards (Fig. 2).



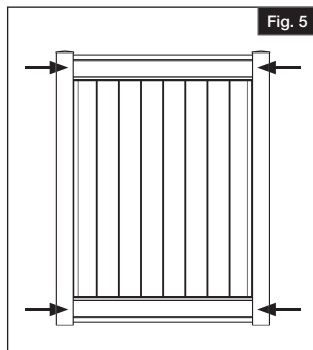
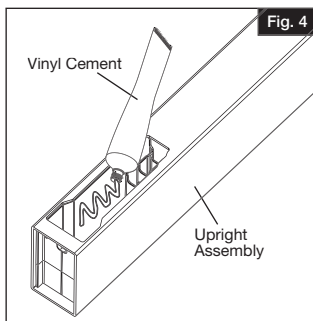
For Lattice Top, Open Picket Top, And Closed Picket Top Styles:

- a. Slide the boards into the bottom rail, starting and ending with end boards while locking each of them together (Fig. 2).
- b. Slide the middle rail over the boards.
- c. Insert lattice/pickets into middle rail (Fig. 3).
- d. Slide the top rail over the lattice/pickets (Fig. 3).



3.

- a. Apply provided vinyl cement to all inside surfaces of the uprights where the rails will be installed (Fig. 4).
- b. Attach uprights to rails (Fig. 5).



4.

Ensure gate is square. Measure diagonally from top of left corner rail (A) to bottom of right corner rail (B) and note the length. Then, measure diagonally from top of right corner rail (C) to bottom of left corner rail (D). Note the length. Make sure both measurements are the same before installing screws into uprights (Fig. 6).

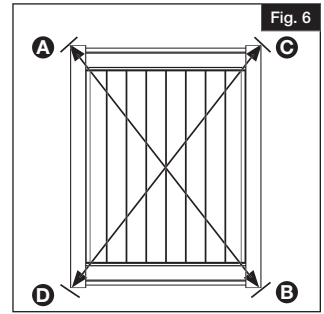

Install two 6" screws (provided) through each upright insert and into the rail using the molded grooves on the insert as a guide (Fig. 7).

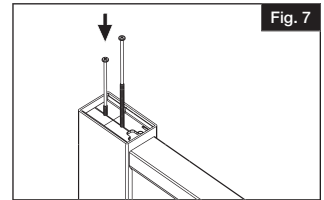

Install upright caps onto the top of each upright with remaining vinyl cement (Fig. 8).

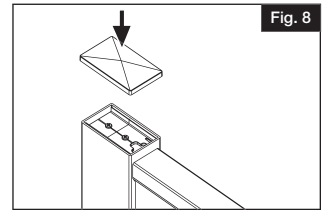

Attaching Boerboel® Hinge To The Upright:

- Attaching the hinges to the inside of the gate will allow the gate to open inward. When attaching them to the outside, the gate will swing outward.
- Mark and pre-drill $\frac{3}{32}$ " pilot holes on top and bottom upright. Secure using six $1\frac{1}{2}$ " screws (provided with the hinge) to front and side of the upright (Fig. 9). Repeat for the bottom hinge.

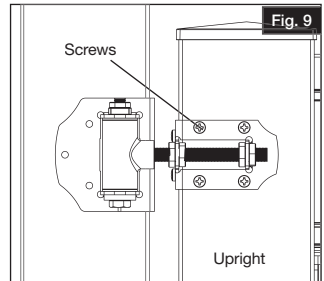

Hold the gate level to the post, pre-drill holes with $\frac{3}{32}$ " bit and secure with six $1\frac{1}{2}$ " screws to the post (Fig. 10). Repeat for the bottom hinge.

NOTE:

Use 2" blocks to align the gate with the fence and help hold the gate steady (Fig. 11).

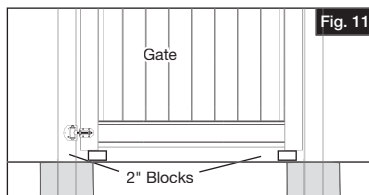

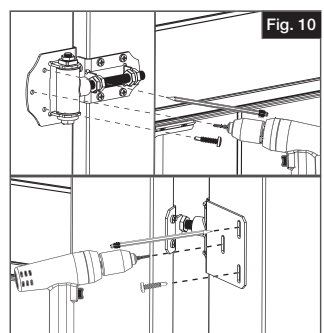

Install Boerboel® Latch:

- Hold latch against the side of the post and mark locations of pilot holes, as shown (Fig. 12).
- Drill four $\frac{3}{32}$ " pilot holes into the post.
- Place four 1" screws (provided with latch) through the screw holes on the larger, side-surface of the post plate (Fig. 13).
- Place the four spacers onto the screws (on the opposite side of the post plate), so they will be between the post plate and the post when post plate is mounted (Fig. 13).
- Secure latch to side of post with four 1" Phillips screws (Fig. 14).

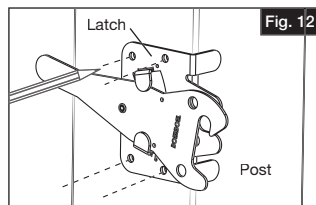

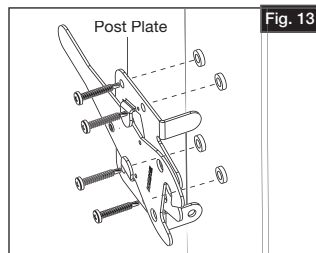

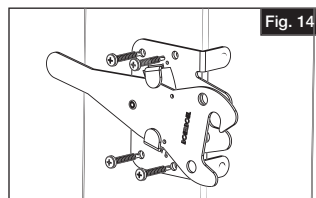

Install Striker Bar:

- Close the gate and insert striker bar into latch, while holding it firmly against the gate.
- Mark pilot holes through the screw holes (Fig. 15).
- Remove striker bar and drill $\frac{3}{32}$ " pilot holes.
- Place striker bar on gate and secure with six 1" Phillips screws (provided with latch).

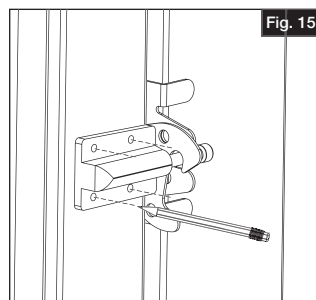

NOTE:

A padlock can be placed through the holes at the top of the latch for added security.

Finishing Options:

- Add a Boerboel® gate handle and Boerboel® gate stop (sold separately) to prolong the life of your gate (Fig. 16).

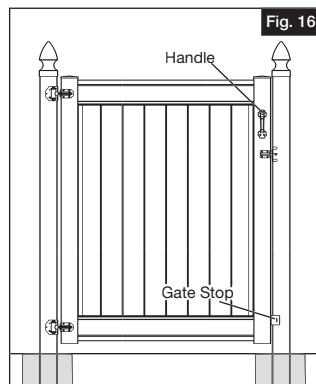

Transferable Limited Lifetime Warranty

What is covered: Barrette Outdoor Living warrants vinyl and aluminum products to include; vinyl and aluminum fence, vinyl and aluminum railing and plastic lattice against defects in materials or workmanship for as long as you own your home. Barrette Outdoor Living will at its option replace the product in question with new product of the same or equivalent value at no charge. Barrette Outdoor Living warrants these products against peeling, flaking, splintering, corrosion, rusting or abnormal discoloration under normal use. This warranty extends to the original purchaser or transferee as specified herein on the products noted above. Separate and distinct warranties for hardware and other products are not covered under this warranty.

What this warranty does not cover: This limited warranty does not cover damage resulting from accident, unreasonable use, neglect, alteration, improper service, improper installation, acts of God or any other causes not arising out of defects in materials or workmanship. Additionally, this warranty does not cover costs of installation, removal, reinstallation or surface mold and mildew created by excessive environmental conditions. Any service or repair provided outside the scope of this limited warranty shall be at Barrette Outdoor Living's rate and terms then in effect.

What do we do to correct the problems? Should your Barrette Outdoor Living product prove defective under warranty, reference the website or call the phone number listed below. Your problem will be assigned a tracking number and an authorized Barrette Outdoor Living representative will contact you to arrange a convenient time to schedule an onsite inspection, or request pictures, if need be. If after inspection product is deemed to be manufacturer defect we will make arrangements to rectify the issue. You must have proof of your purchase in order for the problem to be corrected.

Transferee Coverage: Warranty coverage will be extended to one transferee on the above listed products with the following limitations. Transferee must obtain an original or copy of the initial sales receipt (with proof of date) from the previous owner(s). Additionally, if fence is purchased from a builder or installer, documentation must be supplied that names the product installed on property and date of transfer.

Registration: To activate this warranty, the online registration card must be completed and returned to Barrette Outdoor Living within 30 days of installation.

Additionally, this Warranty does not cover damage associated with surface mold and mildew resulting from environmental conditions including air pollution, or any other causes not arising out of defects in materials or workmanship by Barrette Outdoor Living.

This Warranty does not cover costs of removal or disposal of product, or reinstallation of replacement product. Any service provided outside the scope of this limited Warranty shall be at Barrette Outdoor Living's standard rate and terms then in effect.

Barrette Outdoor Living reserves the right to discontinue or modify any of its products, including the color of its products, without notice to the homeowner/consumer, and Barrette Outdoor Living does not warrant that any replacement material will match or be identical to the original product as replacement products may vary in color or gloss in comparison to the original product as a result of normal weathering. If Barrette Outdoor Living replaces any material under this Warranty, it may substitute products designated by Barrette Outdoor Living to be of comparable quality or price range in the event the product initially installed has been discontinued or modified.
