*About This Variety:* Yucca filamentosa, is commonly called Adam's needle, Spanish bayonet, yucca and needle palm. Can grow up to 8 feet tall.

Growing Instructions: Once they mature, yucca require little care apart from light pruning, yearly feeding and weekly watering.

Care Tip: Newly planted palms need extra moisture during their first year in the garden to ensure they form a solid root system.

Blooms: Summer Exposure: Full sun Height: Grows 4-8' tall Spacing: Plant 24-36" apart, 1.5-2" deep USDA Zones: Hardy In USDA zones 5-10
