

A ready-mixed, ready-to-use aluminum paint formulated with the finest grade leafing aluminum pigments, long wearing oils, and synthetic resins.

USE IT ON: Interior or exterior metal, wood, or masonry surfaces, Recommended for radiators, boilers, smoke stacks, and other surfaces where a heat-resistant coating is necessary. This coating derives its brilliance from a surface leafing pigment. Therefore, it should not be used on any surface subject to abrasion or

SURFACE PREPARATION: All surfaces, new or previously painted, must be clean, dry and free of oil, dirt, grease, mildew, and rust. Rusted metal should be cleaned with a wire brush or sandpaper. Remove loose, scaling paint by wire brushing, scraping, or sanding. Glossy surfaces, and all protected areas not exposed to normal weathering, should be dulled by sanding. Remove oilly residues from new metal surfaces by cleaning with rags saturated in mineral spirits. Surfaces with extensive rust or heavy oxidation should be cleaned to remove loose scale, dust and, debris. New masonry surfaces should be allowed to age at least 90 days before

Stir the remainder to a uniform consistency. making sure that all aluminum pigments are evenly dispersed. Add the removed portion back into the can while mixing thoroughly. Stir occasionally during application. Apply the paint with a good quality polyester brush, short nap roller or spray equipment. The paint should be applied liberally, finishing off in one direction. Painting should not be done during the extreme heat of the day, when the temperature is likely to fall below 50°F, or when rain is expected within 24 hours. If painting a metal roof, avoid painting when the surface is hot or in direct sunlight. Do not apply to hot surfaces. DO NOT THIN.

DRY TIME: 4 to 6 hours to touch: 24 hours to recoat. Temperature and humidity may affect drying time.

COVERAGE: Up to 3,000 sq. ft. (278 sq. meters) per 5 gallon pail on smooth surfaces. Porous surfaces require more paint. Coverage figures do not include spray loss, loss due to surface irregularities and porosity, nor material loss when mixing.
