- DO NOT stand inside the locker during fan installation.
- Its customer's responsibility that the fan installation meet the **National Electrical Code**.
- Customer has to purchase aftermarket fan. 90mm to 120mm width (3.5in to 4.72in) are the recommended fan sizes. Please refer to the minimum and maximum W X H hole locations on the fan to ensure fans are compatible.
- Refer to the mounting hole diameter below. The outer diameter of the Bolts should be 0.2 in/ 5.08 mm or smaller.
