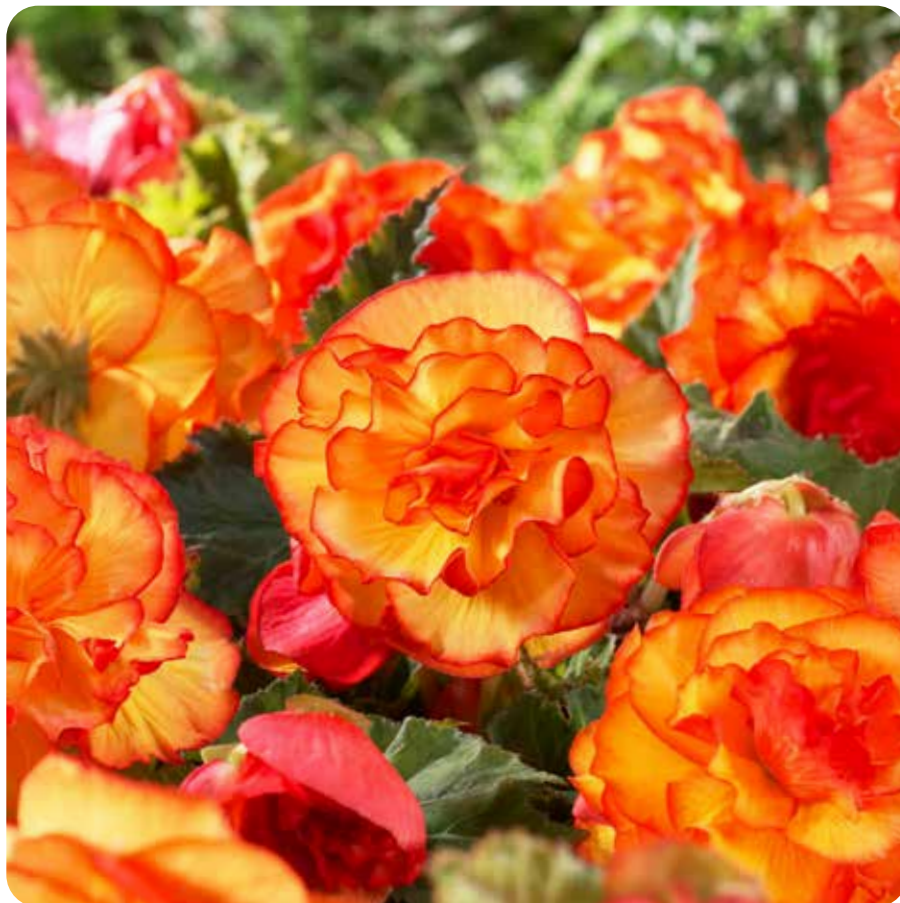

Soil Preparation

Great gardens start with great soil!
Soil preparation is essential for successful gardening.

Healthy soil should have good tilth, nutrient content, and a viable population of beneficial microorganisms. We recommend using natural and organic ingredients to prepare the soil and maintain soil fertility. It is always a good idea to have a soil test to identify your soil type (sandy, loam, silt, clay) and find out your soil pH.

NOTE: It is important to store correctly until planting. Store in a cool, dry place with plenty of air circulation. Plant in spring as soon as ground has thawed and soil has warmed to 50°F and is workable. Usually 4-6 weeks after the last frost.

Begonia Planting Instructions

- 1 Select a well-drained location that receives full shade to partial sun.
- 2 Loosen soil and dig a hole a little deeper than the indicated depth.
- 3 Plant Begonia bulbs horizontally with the hollow side facing up. Tilt the bulb a little (about 60°) so water does not collect in the hollow. Keep the top of the bulb about 1-2" below the soil surface and each bulb about 5-6" apart.
- 4 After planting, water well so that the soil above the bulbs settles. Keep soil moist during periods of dry weather but do not overwater.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q. Can I grow the Begonia Picotee Sunburst in containers?

A. Yes, the Begonia Picotee Sunburst is perfect for containers! Just make sure the container has drainage holes, and place it in a location with partial shade to full sun. This variety thrives in pots and will bring vibrant color to patios, balconies, and small garden spaces.

Q. How often should I water my Begonia bulbs?

A. Water your begonias regularly to keep the soil consistently moist, but not soggy. During the growing season, water when the top inch of soil feels dry. Be sure to avoid overwatering, as begonias prefer well-drained soil and can suffer from root rot if left in standing water.

Q. Are Begonia Picotee Sunburst bulbs deer and rabbit resistant?

A. Yes, begonias are generally deer and rabbit resistant. These animals tend to avoid begonias due to their texture and scent. While no plant is completely immune to browsing, begonias are typically not a preferred food source for deer or rabbits.
