For a thicker application, leave open 15-20 minutes before using. For best results, apply paint with an Amy Howard at Home China Brush. Apply one coat and allow to dry approximately 30 minutes. Do not sand. A second coat is recommended for best coverage. For an antiqued satin finish, use Amy Howard at Home * Clear Wax and/or Dark Wax. Allow wax to dry 30 minutes and buff to get a beautiful Old World look. Use Amy Howard at Home Dust of Ages after waxing to accentuate and age any carved details on your piece.
