


CERAMIC BIRDBATH

Review all assembly and care information before using this product. Save this manual for future reference.

Assemble components on a soft, clean surface to avoid damaging the finish.

NOTE: Color and texture variations of glazed ceramics is normal. The natural characteristics of clay, ingredients and colourants used when mixing each batch of glaze, as well as the dipping, drying and firing processes lead to variation in color. No two glazed ceramic pieces will be identical. Variations in colors and textures are not a cause for return.

CHOOSING A LOCATION

Before assembly, carefully choose the location of the bird bath. Select a flat, level surface. If placing the bird bath on a rough surface, such as on decorative rocks, we highly recommended using a large stepping stone or paver to prevent chipping and damaging the finish.

When moving the bird bath, remove the bowl from the pedestal; lifting the assembled bird bath while the bowl is attached to the pedestal may result in permanent damage that will not be covered by the product warranty.

ASSEMBLY

1. Gently place the pedestal in the desired location.
2. Align the notches on Bowl (A) with the grooves in Pedestal (B) and gently place the bowl onto the pedestal.
3. Gently but firmly twist the bowl to lock it onto the pedestal.

CLEANING

Cleaning 1-2 times per week is recommended.

1. Empty the old, stagnant water.
2. Wash the bowl using warm water and a soft cloth.
3. Rinse the glass bowl thoroughly with running water.
4. Fill the bowl with fresh, clean water.

- Do not install on uneven surfaces or loose soil.

- During freezing weather, empty the birdbath and store indoors; prolonged exposure to freezing temperatures as well as sudden temperature changes may cause the birdbath to crack or break.
