Name: Day & Night Handheld Color Video Monitor with Night Vision

Product Use: To electronically monitor another area of a person's home. The monitor is used mainly to visually monitor a baby or child, an infirmed adult, or an elderly live-in relative. A non-invasive way to keep an eye on another person and allows the freedom to respond only when there is a need. Suitable for indoor use only.



General Description:

The **Day & Night Handheld Color Video Monitor with Night Vision** from Summer Infant is a truly portable unit that allows parent's to see as well as hear their baby while moving around the house. It's ideal for checking on baby without waking him or her. There are also traditional sound lights that visually show baby's level of activity. Nighttime LED lights on the camera make the baby fully visible both day and night. The portable video monitor has rechargeable batteries plus an A/C adaptor and offers a belt clip and kickstand for extra convenience.

Installation: 5-10 minutes if camera is placed on tabletop. 15-20 minutes if camera is hardware-mounted to the wall.

FAQ's:

If you have more than one monitor set will it interfere with one another?

If you experience interference with your monitor, make sure there are no other 900 MHz products (such as a cordless phone) located near the monitor. Also, try changing the channels on both monitor and camera from A to B or B to A. Discontinuing use of other 900 MHz cordless products will also help.

How do you view two rooms?

If you have two cameras hooked up to one monitor, make sure one of the room's transmitters (Baby's unit) is on Channel A and one room is on Channel B. You can then switch back and forth between rooms by switching the channels on the receiver (Parent's unit).

How do you charge the battery on the Parent's Unit?

Plug in the A/C adaptor while connected to the handheld unit and let it charge to restore the battery power.

What is the life span of a rechargeable battery?

Under normal use the battery is designed to last up to 10 hours with each use and have a total lifespan of 18 months. Replacement batteries can be ordered via www.summerinfant.com or by contacting Summer's Consumer Relations department at 1-800-268-6237.

Page Three: Day & Night Handheld Color Video Monitor with Night Vision

Is the Handheld monitor supposed to turn off if not plugged in?

Yes. The monitor has a power saver feature and will go into sleep mode after 3 minutes in order to conserve the battery. Simply press the Video On/Off button to reactivate the unit.

What is the range of the monitors?

Up to 350 feet under normal use.

What is the frequency of the Handheld monitor?

900 MHz.

Troubleshooting Helpful Hints

- During use at night, the closer the Parent's unit is to the Baby's unit, the better the picture quality. The farther the distance away, the picture may get grainy. Optimal distance for normal in home use is 15-60 feet. Also, too close (about 15 feet or less), audio feedback could result.
- Optimal distance for the camera from the child for night vision is 4 to 6 feet. Over 6 feet and the picture may get grainy due to the lack of light. Any additional light source in the room, such as a night-light, may improve the vision.
- Video monitors are a wireless product and are therefore subject to a number of environmental conditions. Walking between and near the Parent's unit may cause temporary interference.
- Better reception can often be accomplished by changing the position of the Parent's unit on the counter or table thereby repositioning the antenna.
