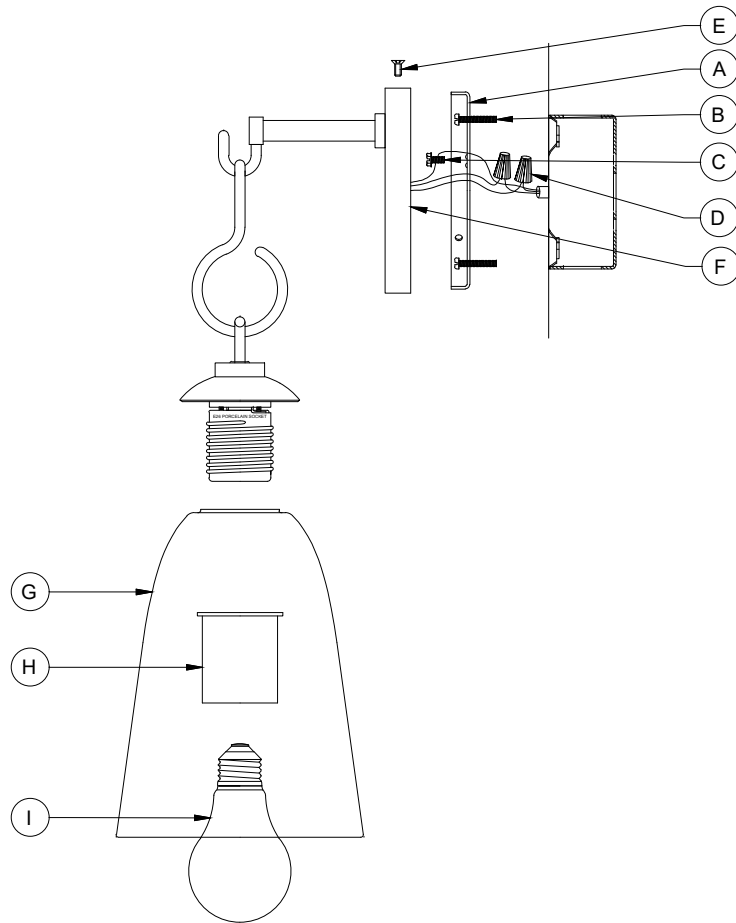


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Attach the MOUNTING PLATE (A) onto the junction box using the MOUNTING SCREWS (B). This fixture is designed to be mounted on standard round or octagon junction box. The junction box must be securely mounted to the structure of the building.
2. Attach the Ground wire to the ground inside the outlet box or the GROUND SCREW (C) on the MOUNTING PLATE (A).
3. Connect the white fixture lead to the neutral wire in the outlet box. Fasten the wires together with an approved fastener (WIRE NUT)(D). Starting below the fastener, tightly wrap the connection with electrical tape so that the connections seal the end of the fastener.
4. Connect the black fixture leads to the hot wire in the junction box. Fasten the joined wires same as previous step.
5. Attach the FIXTURE ASSEMBLY (F) to the MOUNTING PLATE (A) and secure with the FIXTURE MOUNTING SCREWS (E).
6. Lift the GLASS (G) up onto the FIXTURE ASSEMBLY (F) and secure by using the RING (H)
7. Screw the BULB (I) up into the SOCKET of the fixture. THIS FIXTURE IS RATED FOR MAX 60 WATT TYPE A LAMP. DO NOT EXCEED THE RECOMMENDED WATTAGE!
8. Restore power to the outlet at the breaker or fuse box.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
