# Assembly of fire pit

# Attaching the legs

- Place the stand ring (E) on a soft, flat surface and align the bolt holes on the legs (G) with the holes on the stand ring (E).
- □ Loosely secure the legs (G) to the stand ring (E) with bolts (AA).



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### Assembling the bowl and log grate

- Carefully turn the stand assembly to the upright position and place the bowl (D) into the stand.
- □ Place the log grate (C) into the bowl (D).



## **2** Attaching the leg connector ring

- Place the leg connector ring (F) between the legs (G) and insert bolts (AA) through the leg connector ring (F) and into each leg (G).
- Once all of the bolts (AA) are in place and the stand assembly is aligned properly, tighten all bolts (AA) with the Allen Key (CC).



## Assembling the mesh cover

- Attach the cover handle (A) to the mesh cover (B) by inserting the cover handle (A) through the top of the mesh cover (B) and securing with a nut (BB).
- **□** Tighten the nut with a wrench (not included).
- Carefully place the assembled cover (B) On the bowl (D). The fire bowl is ready for use.

## Attaching the legs

- Place the stand ring (E) on a soft, flat surface and align the bolt holes on the legs (G) with the holes on the stand ring (E).
- □ Loosely secure the legs (G) to the stand ring (E) with bolts (AA).





## Assembling the bowl and log grate

- Carefully turn the stand assembly to the upright position and place the bowl (D) into the stand.
- □ Place the log grate (C) into the bowl (D).



## **2** Attaching the leg connector ring

- Place the leg connector ring (F) between the legs (G) and insert bolts (AA) through the leg connector ring (F) and into each leg (G).
- Once all of the bolts (AA) are in place and the stand assembly is aligned properly, tighten all bolts (AA) with the Allen Key (CC).



- Assembling the tray top
  - Carefully place the tray top (I) On the bowl (D). The table is ready for use.

# Starting a fire



WARNING: Do not use charcoal or an artificial log.



WARNING: Do not use large logs. Do not overload the fire bowl beyond 6 to 8 pounds.



**WARNING:** Do not use gasoline or kerosene to start a fire.

**CAUTION:** Keep the fire at a reasonable level as large fires can damage or shorten the life of the unit.

- Place three to four sheets of crumpled newspaper on top of the fire log grate (C).
- Pile finely-split, dry firewood on top of the loosely crumpled newspaper.
- Carefully light the loosely crumpled newspaper underneath the firewood and carefully replace the mesh cover (A) using the hook (H).

# **2** Adding wood to an existing fire

- Use the hook (H) to lift the handle (A) on the mesh cover (B) and carefully add wood while the fire is burning.
- Use the hook (H) to carefully replace the mesh cover (A) back onto the bowl (D).





# Once the fireplace is completely cooled down, remove the mesh cover using the handle. Pour the ashes from the bowl and rinse with clean water and allow to dry completely.

- □ Clean after each use.
- Do not use a scrub brush.
- □ If the paint chips, use only high-temperature paints and a brush to fix.
- □ If rust is showing, sand lightly and repaint the area with high-temperature paints.
- $\Box$  Dry with a soft cloth.
- Turn the unit upside down when not in use to prevent water from collecting.
- Cover the unit when not in use to prolong the life.
- $\hfill\square$  Keep your firepit out of rain.
- $\hfill\square$   $\hfill$  Do not place the tray top when fire pit in use.

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
