



WARNINGS


- · Risk of electric shock Disconnect power at the source before installation.
- If you are unsure about the installation or the maintenance of the wall light, please consult an electrician.
- · Do not make or alter any holes in the wiring enclosure or modify any electrical componentry.

CAUTIONS

- To insure personal safety, proper grounding of the electrical fixture is required.
- The fixture must be wired in accordance with the National Electric Code and applicable local codes or ordinances.
- Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.

WIRING AND FIXTURE MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.
- If you are replacing an exisitng fixture, remove and disconnect the old fixture first.
- 1. Expose the supply wires from the outlet box.
- 2. Remove MOUNTING BRACKET from fixture and install to ELECTRICAL BOX using FIXTURE SCREWS. Make sure you feed the supply wires through the center hole of the mounting bracket.
- 3. Tie ground wire from OUTLET BOX and from fixture (bare wire) to the GROUND SCREW on the MOUNTING BRACKET.
- 4. Connect white wire from fixture to white wire (neutral wire) from supply
- 5. Connect black wire from fixture to black wire (live wire) from supply circuit. Cover connections using provided WIRE CONNECTORS.
- 6. Taking care, tuck the wires back into the outlet box.
- 7. Attach the fixture back plate to MOUNTING BRACKET and tighten BALL NUTS so fixture meets wall. FIXTURE SCREWS should protrude from FIXTURE BACK PLATE 1/4".
- 8. Install supplied bulb or desired bulb into fixture (if you are using another bulb observe fixture's max wattage rating label).
- 9. Slide the GLASS SHADE over the bulb and rotate securely into place.
- 10. Final Assembly Attach LAMP SHADE and rotate securely into place.
- 11. The installation is now complete. Restore the electricity and check the operation of your lighting fixture.
