New Lawns & Lawn Patches **Césped nuevo y parcelas de césped**

Spread 2" (5 cm) layer of peat across the lawn. Rototill or dig it into the top 6" (15 cm) of soil. After seeding, fertilizing and watering lightly, carefully spread a ½" (1 cm) top dressing. Moisten daily for 2-3 weeks.



New Flower Beds & Vegetable Gardens **Nuevos macizos de flores y huertas**

Spread 2" (5 cm) of peat across the bed surface. Rototill or dig into top 6" (15 cm) of soil.



Existing Flower Beds & Vegetable Gardens **Macizos de flores y huertas preexistentes**

Spread 1" (2.5 cm) of peat across the bed surface. Rototill or dig into top 6" (15 cm) of soil. Take care when working into soil around existing plants to avoid root damage.



Bulb Beds **Macizos de bulbos**

Spread 2" (5 cm) of peat across the bed. Work into the soil to the same depth the bulbs are to be planted.



Trees & Shrubs **Árboles y arbustos**

Dig hole three times the width of the root ball and just as deep. Slope the sides of the hole outward to 45 degrees. Loosen bottom of hole with garden fork. Mix 1 part peat with 2 parts soil removed from the hole. Backfill in around the root ball with the peat-soil mix. Water thoroughly and allow to settle. Add remaining peat soil mix. Water twice a week for 3-4 weeks.

Acidic-Soil Plants **Plantas de suelo ácido**

For acidic soil plants (azaleas, rhododendrons, roses, conifers, etc.) combine equal parts peat and soil in backfill mix.



Garden Compost **Compost para jardín**

Combine equal parts peat moss and compost. Spread a 2" (5 cm) layer of the mixture across the garden bed and rototill or dig it into the top 6" (15 cm) of soil.

Compost Bins **Recipientes de compost**

Blend 1" (2.5 cm) of peat moss into every 4" (10 cm) of compostable garden material. Add a 2" (5 cm) peat "cap" to help control odor.
