I. INTRODUCTION

Proper care ensures optimal performance and longevity of your ZEVNI lighting fixtures. Follow these guidelines to maintain illumination quality, energy efficiency, and safety.

II. ROUTINE MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

1. Dust Prevention & Removal

- Frequency: Wipe fixtures weekly using a microfiber or lint-free cloth.
- Purpose: Prevents buildup that reduces light output and aesthetic appeal.
- Note: Avoid abrasive materials to prevent surface scratches.

2. Cleaning Procedures

Step 1: Power Off

Ensure the fixture is switched off and bulbs are cool (wait at least 15 minutes after use).

Step 2: Surface Cleaning

- Use a dry, lint-free cloth for general wiping.
- For stubborn residues, lightly dampen the cloth with distilled water or a mild soap solution.
- Do not spray liquid directly onto fixtures.
- Avoid ammonia or alcohol-based cleaners, which may damage finishes.

Step 3: Glass Component Care

- Remove detachable glass panels or globes (if applicable).
- Wash with mild soap and lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air-dry completely before reassembly.

Warning: Never allow moisture to contact electrical components, sockets, or wiring.

3. Bulb Replacement Protocol

Compliance: Use only bulbs that match the fixture's specified wattage and base type (refer to the product label or user manual).

Procedure:

- a) Disconnect power at the circuit breaker.
- b) Allow the existing bulb to cool completely.
- c) Double-check the compatibility of the replacement bulb.
- d) Install the new bulb without overtightening.

Risk Alert: Using incorrect bulbs can cause overheating, fixture damage, or fire hazards.

III. PERIODIC INSPECTIONS

1. Visual Checks

- **Monthly:** Check for loose screws, unstable mounting, or visible corrosion.
- **Annually:** Have a licensed electrician inspect wiring for signs of fraying, exposed conductors, or socket discoloration.

2. Professional Servicing

- **Complex Fixtures:** Chandeliers, recessed lighting, and integrated LED systems should be inspected by a licensed electrician every 2–3 years.
- **Immediate Attention:** If flickering, buzzing, or intermittent operation occurs, discontinue use immediately and contact a professional technician.

IV. ENERGY EFFICIENCY PRACTICES

- **Switch Off When Not in Use:** Reduces energy consumption and extends the life of bulbs and fixtures.
- **Consider Timers or Motion Sensors:** Automate lighting in low-use areas such

as closets, hallways, or outdoor spaces.

- **Use LED Bulbs:** Where compatible, LED bulbs provide significant energy savings and a longer lifespan compared to incandescent or halogen alternatives.

V. IMPORTANT SAFETY

- **Voltage Compliance:** Never exceed the fixture's rated voltage or wattage (refer to the product label for specified ratings).
- **Avoid DIY Repairs:** All electrical modifications or internal repairs must be performed by a licensed professional.
- **Child & Pet Safety:** Secure any dangling cords and position floor lamps or table lamps away from high-traffic areas to prevent tipping or entanglement.
