

JUNKYARD GODDESS HEMP OIL

Junkyard Goddess Hemp Oil is used to seal and protect a variety of surfaces. Because it is a "drying" oil, it will produce a hard, polymer-like finish once it cures, which gives excellent protection against water, stains and scratches. An important distinction between polyurethanes and hemp oil is that hemp oil is food safe, naturally non-toxic, and chemical and solvent free. It is 100% naturally-derived and extracted by cold pressing the seeds found in the fruit of the Cannabis Sativa plant. Hemp oil has a multitude of functions and benefits, including:



- Revitalizes Worn Wood Furnishings
- Seals & Protects Milk or Chalk Painted Surfaces *
- Finishes & Protects Wood-stained Pieces
- Protects Unfinished Wood, i.e. Cutting Boards
- Removes Oxidation from Metal
- Hydrates and Nourishes Leather, Skin & More

DIRECTIONS:

Apply a small amount to a brush or soft cloth and rub gently into surface. Allow several hours to dry, then wipe away excess. For added lustre and protection, apply additional coats. Over time (between two to four weeks, depending upon temperature and humidity) the hemp oil will harden and become one with the surface (cure). Pieces may be used during this period ~ simply take care to protect from water and heavy wear and tear.

** Painted wood surface must be matte (porous). Hemp Oil is not effective on latex or enamel finishes.*
