1 Plug machine cord into properly grounded wall outlet or grounded extension cord.

2 Position as necessary. See Application Chart.

- 0° for surface air flow. Also can be inserted under the edges of carpets.

- 30° for walls, furnishings and ventilation.

- 90° for ceilings and ventilation such as in factories or warehouses.

3 Turn switch and select desired speed setting- LOW - MEDIUM - HIGH

Use low or medium speed for applications where high air volume is not recommended.

Use high speed for faster drying of surfaces and carpets.

4 When complete, turn switch to OFF position.

5 Wrap cord around holder.
