

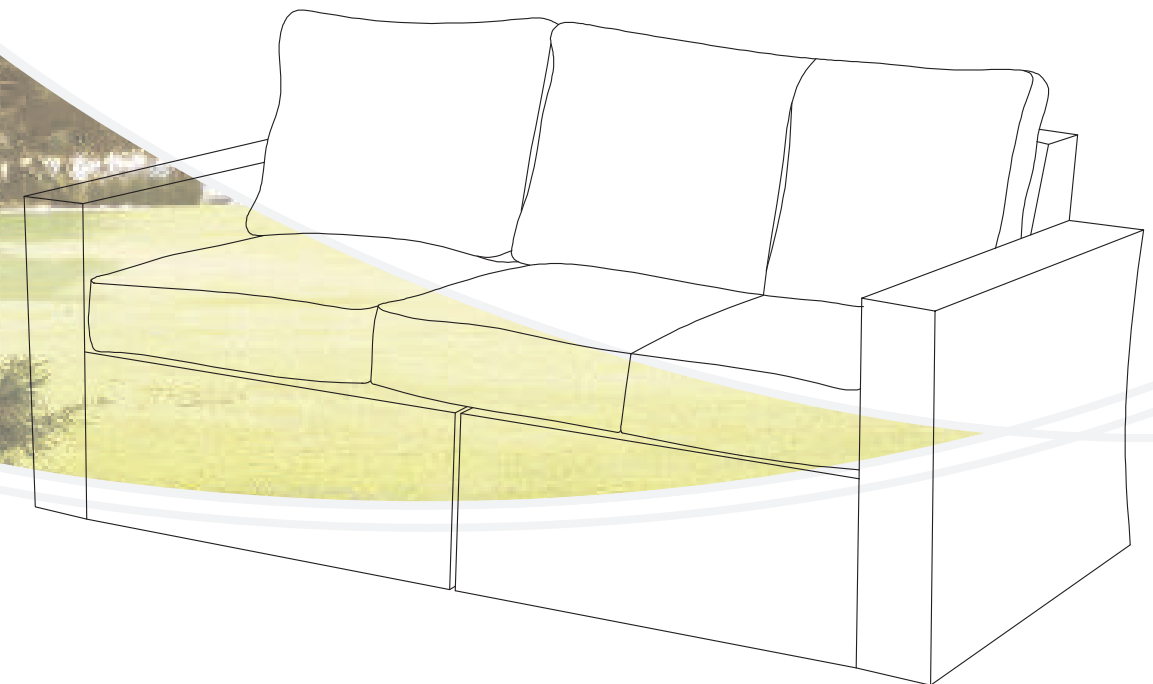

CAUTION: Read all the instructions before assembly. Failure to do so may result in faulty assembly and potential injury!

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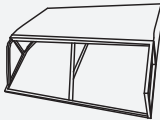
