Water to settle soil. Add layer of mulch to retain moisture and discourage weeds. Water regularly for the first year, then as needed once established. Feed with a quality fertilizer following application and frequency instructions, typically just before and during the bloom season.

Care Tip: Thunderbolt® is a broadleaf evergreen (holds its leaves all year) preferred for its dense, colorful foliage and flexible use in the landscape. You can leave it to cascade naturally, trim lightly to keep a tidy form, or fully shape it into a hedge or topiary. The choice is yours. Be sure to prune when the threat of frost is over to avoid stress or severe damage to the plant.
